



**SYNOPSIS**  
**Solicitation: N69450-13-R-1257**

P655 Broad Area Maritime Surveillance (BAMS) Mission Control Complex, NAS Jacksonville, FL: This facility will be a new freestanding 2-story structure with two EMI shielded Mission Control Systems (MCS), a Tactical Operations Center (TOC) with SCIF spaces and numerous roof-top mounted antennas. This project will renovate some interior spaces within Buildings 850 and 848. The renovations include a reconfigured command suite, systems reconfiguration, and in some cases just finish upgrades. Within the scope of this project antenna infrastructure will be constructed at a remote site south of the new facility construction site. This project includes fiber routing to the remote antenna and to Buildings 506, 27 and 919. The Mission Control Center will be located on the site of existing Building 798 "The Zone". This existing facility will be demolished along with existing parking areas to make way for the new facility. The site layout to the new facility anticipates the Mission Control Center's future expansion as well as project AT/FP standoff and LEED Silver Certification requirements.

The contractor shall perform all services necessary for the construction of the P655 BAMS Mission Control Complex at Naval Air Station Jacksonville, Florida, in accordance with the Request for Proposal (RFP). The total completion time for this project is 500 calendar days from the contract award date. The liquidated damages for this project are \$10,242.00 per calendar day of delay.

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Procurement Method: Contracting by Negotiation - Best Value Lowest price technically acceptable (LPTA)

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The NAICS Code for this procurement is 236220.

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Estimated cost: \$15,000,000 to \$20,000,000

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This is a new procurement. It does not replace an existing contract. No prior contract information exists.

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The proposed contract will be solicited inviting full and open competition. Offerors can view and/or download the solicitation, and any attachments, at <https://www.neco.navy.mil/> when it becomes available.

The solicitation should be available at this site on or about 07 January 2013. Contract Award is anticipated April 2013

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The solicitation utilizes source selection procedures which require offerors to submit a technical proposal, past performance and experience information, and a price proposal for evaluation by the Government.

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Offerors shall submit with their offer a bid bond of at least 20 percent of the bid price but not exceeding \$3 million of the amount, for Davis Bacon Act (DBA) work.

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
