This acquisition will be negotiated with: Lockheed Martin (04939)

NAVSUP Weapon Systems Support, Source Development Department has a breakout program designed to convert as many acquisitions as possible to full and open competition. However, the items that are to be procured under this acquisition are for Interim Supply Support (ISS) of the Infrared Receiver, Infrared Control and Inertia Nav Unit /AN/ASG-34(V)1 Infrared Search and Track (IRST). ISS items are considered design unstable as no formal configuration baseline has been established. Since the Material Support Date (MSD) is scheduled for Jan, 2020, reprourement technical data has not yet been developed, and will not be available in time to support Initial Operating Capability (IOC). It is anticipated that technical data will be provided to the Navy at a later date, at which time the technical data will be evaluated to determine if it is suitable for competition, as well as evaluating the feasibility of any other alternatives for achieving and/or enhancing, competition.

6. DESCRIPTION OF EFFORTS MADE TO SOLICIT OFFERS FROM AS MANY OFFERORS AS PRACTICABLE:

Market research was conducted in accordance with FAR Part 10. The results of the market research conducted are as follows: The NAVSUP Weapon Systems Support (WSS) F/A18 A-G Avionics Technical Department has conducted the market research per the market research document. The subject item is a Critical Application Item (CAI) and all alternate sources must qualify IAW the design control activity's procedures, as approved by The NAVSUP WSS 07 prior to contract award. At this time no other commercial facilities have the expertise, facilities or the test equipment necessary to produce the 797231990-009 Infrared Receiver, 79920260-009 Infrared Control and 79799350-009 Inertia Nav Unit for the AN/ASG-34(V)1 Infrared Search and Track (IRST) other than Lockheed Martin (04939) due to the proprietary drawing owned by Lockheed Martin (04939) that are essential to produce 797231990-009, 79920260-009 and 79799350-009 spares. No other sources have currently expressed an interest in becoming an approved source of spares for the subject item to the source Development Department.

7. DETERMINATION OF FAIR AND REASONABLE COST: The contracting officer determines that the anticipated cost to the Government of the supplies covered by this J&A will be fair and reasonable.

8. ACTIONS TO REMOVE BARRIERS TO FUTURE COMPETITION:

For reasons set forth in paragraph (5) and (6), NAVSUP WSS has no plans at this time to compete future contracts for the types of supplies/services covered by this document. If another potential source emerges, NAVSUP WSS will assess whether competition for future requirements is feasible.
