- 4. **STATUTORY AUTHORITY PERMITTING OTHER THAN FULL AND OPEN COMPETITION:** This J&A is based upon the authority of 10 USC 2304(c)(1), one source or limited sources, as implemented by FAR 6.302-1.
- 5. **RATIONALE JUSTIFYING USE OF CITED STATUTORY AUTHORITY:**

The current Acquisition Method Code/Acquisition Method Suffix Code (AMC/AMSC) is: 3 B multiple codes see pg 2 for definitions

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AMC 3. Acquire, for the second or subsequent time, directly from the actual manufacturer.

AMSC B. This part must be acquired from a manufacturing source(s) specified on a source control or selected item drawing as defined by the current version of DoD-STD-100. Suitable technical data, Government data rights, or manufacturing knowledge are not available to permit acquisition from other sources, nor qualification testing of another part, nor use of a second source part in the intended application. Data review discloses that required data or data rights are not in Government possession and cannot be economically obtained.

This acquisition will be negotiated with: Honeywell International (70210)

Honeywell International P/N: 2215530-3-1, (70210) is the only Approved Source of Supply that manufactures, and tests the E-2C Hawkeye, and the E-2D Advanced Hawkeye Aircraft, 15 Ton Evaporation Unit I/A/W Northrop Grumman Source Control Drawing 123SECS5170-7, approved by NAVAIR, PMA-231, and FRCSW North Island. Honeywell International (70210) is only bidding facility, at this time, that owns the test equipment, and has the expertise, facilities, and capability, necessary to manufacture, and test the subject 15 Ton Evaporation Unit used on the E-2C Hawkeye, and the E-2D Advanced Hawkeye Aircraft. This is a Critical Application Item.

6. DESCRIPTION OF EFFORTS MADE TO SOLICIT OFFERS FROM AS MANY OFFERORS AS PRACTICABLE: The proposed contract action was synopsised and included a Sources Sought Notice on the FedBizOpps website for government-wide point of entry on

21 March 2016

and as a result:

No interest from other sources, at this time.

Market Research was conducted in accordance with FAR part 10. The results of the Market Research conducted (or the reason market research was not conducted) is as follows:

The data necessary to facilitate procurement of this Evaporator Unit, from sources other than Honeywell (70210), is source controlled (3B). Potential new sources of supply will require approval by Honeywell (70210). NAVAIR has determined this is a Critical Application Item (CAI). Source Development Department files indicate no Source Approval Request (SAR) has been received from any party interested in becoming a source of supply for this item. Honeywell (70210) is the only approved source at this time. *APB*

7. DETERMINATION OF FAIR AND REASONABLE COST: The contracting officer determines that the anticipated cost to the Government of the supplies covered by this J&A will be fair and reasonable.

8. ACTIONS TO REMOVE BARRIERS TO FUTURE COMPETITION:

For reasons set forth in Paragraphs (5) & (6), NAVSUP WSS has no plan at this time to compete future contracts for the types of supplies/ services covered by this document. If another potential source emerges, NAVSUP WSS will assess whether competition for future requirements is feasible.
