These respirator assemblies are used at PSNS & IMF in order to protect the personnel from airborne contaminants. The MSA spectacle kit #454819 was produced by the manufacture MSA so that prescription lenses can be used with the two (2) respirator assemblies without compromising the integrity of the respirator assembly.

There are no other spectacle kits that will fit the MSA Ultra-Twin and Ultravue series face pieces in the existing respirators. PSNS will continue to complete market research, to identify if any alternative sources or aftermarket parts are compatible with the current MSA Ultra-Twin and Ultravue respirator units that will not compromise the integrity of the system. If there are any alternative sources then PSNS will compete the Spectacle kits in a "brand name or equal" procurement with salient characteristics identified.

A new respirator assembly costs approximately [REDACTED] per unit. Purchasing spectacle kits for prescription lenses will save the expense of purchasing a whole new respirator assembly for each person's prescription.
