1. IDENTIFICATION OF AGENCY AND/OR CONTRACTING ACTIVITY:

Requiring Activity: NAVSUP WSS-Mechanicsburg.
Contracting Activity: DLA Maritime at Mechanicsburg.

2. NATURE/DESCRIPTION OF ACTION: This J&A is for the negotiation and award of an indefinite delivery (Requirements) Contract through other than full and open competition. This contract will establish prices which will be valid for a period of up to three years. This includes a base period of one year plus two one-year option periods.

3. DESCRIPTION OF SUPPLIES/SERVICES: This J&A covers the acquisition of the following two spare parts used in support of the Calibration Standard Weapons System:

4. IDENTIFICATION OF STATUTORY AUTHORITY: This J&A is based upon the authority of 10 USC 2304(c)(1), as implemented by Federal Acquisition Regulation 6.302-1.

5. DEMONSTRATION OF CONTRACTOR'S UNIQUE QUALIFICATIONS: The current Acquisition Method/Suffix Code (AMC/AMSC) is 3H. This acquisition will be negotiated with: KING NUTRONICS CORP., WOODLAND HILLS, CA (CAGE 13859). Only this source will be solicited because the articles to be acquired are highly specialized parts, designed and manufactured by this non-Government activity. The item is critical and must be procured from the actual manufacturer. The Government does not have adequate data, lacks rights to data, or both, needed to purchase this part from additional sources. No other part can be used as a replacement for either of the required items.
6. GOVERNMENTWIDE POINT OF ENTRY NOTICE/POTENTIAL SOURCES: Notice of the planned contract action will be posted at the Government wide Point of Entry: FedBizOpps.
7. DETERMINATION OF FAIR AND REASONABLE COST: The contracting officer determines that the anticipated cost to the Government will be fair and reasonable. Established pricing policies will be followed to ensure acquisition of each item at fair and reasonable prices.
8. DESCRIPTION OF MARKET SURVEY: A technical review has been made to determine and identify all known sources. There is no other known source that has the capability to produce the required items. A market survey was conducted by synthesizing the planned action through the Government wide Point of Entry; any source which demonstrates its capability to supply the required item will be given an opportunity to compete.
9. ANY OTHER SUPPORTING FACTS:
- The model 3731 is a portable, self contained pressure calibrator capable of calibrating pneumatic gauges 600 psig to 6000 psig. It consists of a hand pump, hydraulic reservoir, gauges, high pressure hoses, fittings and maintenance items used for maintenance of the calibrator. All items are contained in a hard shell, waterproof case.
- The two portable pressure calibrators (PPC) provided under this contract are and have been the NAVSEA standard for the past 4 years and are the only acceptable equipment for use within the calibration/test equipment community. During the time this contract has been in place considerable time, monetary resources, and training have been expended to successfully field this equipment. The introduction of any pressure calibrator other than the two specified would result in unnecessary disruption and cost to the testing community and result in mission degradation.
10. LISTING OF INTERESTED SOURCES: The following sources have expressed, in writing, an interest in this acquisition: NONE.
11. ACTIONS TO REMOVE BARRIERS TO COMPETITION:
- The Government will include a clause in the solicitation that provides that the Government will consider alternate offers, and that alternate offerors should submit a source approval request (SAR) package that will be referred to the cognizant engineering activity. If, due to mission requirements, the current procurement cannot be delayed in order to allow sufficient time for the engineering activity to determine whether to approve the alternate offer, the SAR package will be considered for future awards. This item has been reviewed under the NAVSUP WSS limited screen process and it was determined that the item cannot be broken out. No additional actions to remove barriers to competition are required under this process.




