Item description: Item description required for all items: These items are piece parts of a special project to provide long term support of the Seawolf Class Wide Aperture Array (WAA). The WAA is a subsystem of the AN/BSY-2 system, which is a fully integrated system used for sonar tracking, monitoring, and launch of all on-board weapons.

4. IDENTIFICATION OF STATUTORY AUTHORITY: This J&A is based upon the authority of 10 USC 2304(c)(1), as implemented by Federal Acquisition Regulation 6.302-1. The supplies required by the agency are only available from one responsible source or a limited number of sources and no other type of supplies will satisfy agency requirements.

5. DEMONSTRATION OF CONTRACTOR'S UNIQUE QUALIFICATIONS:

The current Acquisition Method Code (AMC/AMCS) is 3R. For the reasons explained below, these supplies are only available from the following source: (07MUL) General Dynamics Information Technology

AMC 3. Acquire for the second or subsequent time directly from the manufacturer.

AMCS R. The Government does not own the data or the rights to the data needed to purchase this part from additional sources. It has been determined to be uneconomical to buy the data or rights to the data. It is uneconomical to reverse engineer the part. This code is used when the Government did not initially purchase the data and/or rights.

General Dynamics IT now owns the rights to the design of these parts. A less restrictive specification does not currently exist and development of such an item at this time would not meet the immediate needs of the fleet. The source engineering activity is the following: Ship Systems Engineering Station, Carderock Division, Naval Surface Warfare Center.

6. GOVERNMENTWIDE POINT OF ENTRY NOTICE/POTENTIAL SOURCES: A presolicitation notice to inform potential sources of this impending requirement as well as the solicitation will be sent to the GPE in accordance with FAR 5.2. This justification and the resultant award will be synopsized via posting to FedBizOpps in accordance with FAR 5.3.

7. DETERMINATION OF FAIR AND REASONABLE COST: The contracting officer determines that the anticipated cost to the Government will be fair and reasonable. In instances when certified cost and pricing data are required, an analysis of cost information will be performed which will consider field pricing reports, commerciality, procurement history and other available cost and pricing information in determining price reasonableness. When certified cost and pricing data is obtained it will be used to ensure reasonableness, completeness and realism of proposed costs as required.

8. DESCRIPTION OF MARKET SURVEY: A technical review, which consisted of searching several Government databases including ITIMP, FLIS and ERP, has been completed on this item. Search criteria included Part Number, Design Control Activity, Cage Code, NSN, Nomenclature, AMC/AMSC, AAC, Criticality Coding, recorded approved sources of supply, historical sources of supply and past

contracts. Based on this market research the contracting officer has determined that the only known manufacturing source is 07MU1. ERP Master Data Base, WEBFLIS data bases were queried through item interrogation to ascertain potential alternate sources that may be identified that would meet the Government's minimum requirements for the tasks. At this time no additional sources were identified through these research efforts.

9. ANY OTHER SUPPORTING FACTS:

The articles to be procured are complex and must meet operational and reliability requirements, the achievement of which requires unique production techniques and extensive and/or sophisticated testing. The approved source retains data rights, manufacturing knowledge, or technical data that are not economically available to the Government, and the data or knowledge is essential to maintaining the quality of the part. An alternate source must qualify in accordance with the design control activity's procedures, as approved by the cognizant Government engineering activity.

11. ACTIONS TO REMOVE BARRIERS TO COMPETITION: The government will include a clause in the solicitation that provides that the government will consider alternate offers, and that alternate offerors should submit a source approval request (SAR) package that will be referred to the NAVSUPWSS technical division for review. Alternate offers submitted may be forwarded to NAVSEA, SPAWAR and the NAVAIR Host Program Offices as appropriate. If due to mission requirements the current procurement cannot be delayed in order to allow sufficient time for approval of alternate offers, the SAR package will be considered for future awards.






