Item description required for all items:
 The above items are all components used in the AN/UYQ-70 weapon system tactical workstation. This flexible, tactical workstation is configured using high-performance COTS modules housed in militarized enclosures. The Q-70 can be installed in airborne, surface and submarine platforms to fulfill multiple combat system tasks. With the capability to emulate legacy display systems, the Q-70 workstation allows for immediate transition to open combat architectures and provides a cost-effective protection of prior hardware and software investments.

4. IDENTIFICATION OF STATUTORY AUTHORITY: This J&A is based upon the authority of 10 USC 2304(c)(1), as implemented by Federal Acquisition Regulation 6.302-1. The supplies required by the agency are only available from one responsible source or a limited number of sources and no other type of supplies will satisfy agency requirements. For those items with the exception of NIIN 01-455-7269, NIIN 01-557-7218 and NIIN 01-599-1476 with previous award history using the authority of 10 USC 2304(C)(1) a C1 J&A was obtained and as stated in the J&A, in order to reduce barriers to competition, the alternate offers clause was included in the solicitation inviting interested parties to submit alternate offers which if received would be forwarded to technical for possible approval on future buys. For NIIN 01-455-7269, NIIN 01-557-7218 and NIIN 01-599-1476, the respective J&A's stated that the alternate offers clause would be included however this clause was inadvertently omitted from the RFP. For this reason, in accordance with PGI 206.304, the current J&A is being approved at one level above the approval level for the prior J&A. For NIIN 01-463-2363, NIIN 01-530-4156 and NIIN 01-543-5697, in addition to the remark about the alternate offers clause a statement was included that the items would be reviewed under the NAVSUP replenishment parts program and should it be determined that the part can be broken out, future acquisitions would be competitive. This language was unintentionally added to these prior J&A's because this program has not existed since the 1990s therefore this action was not performed nor intended to be performed. This is a first time buy using the authority of 10 USC 2304(C)(1) for NIIN 01-492-3934, NIIN 01-504-4862 and NIIN 01-608-9482.

5. DEMONSTRATION OF CONTRACTOR'S UNIQUE QUALIFICATIONS:

The current Acquisition Method Code (AMC/AMCS) is 3R. For the reasons explained below, these supplies are only available from the following source: (52088) Lockheed Martin Corporation

Only this source will be solicited because the articles to be acquired are highly specialized parts, designed and manufactured by this non-Government activity. No other manufacturer's part can be used as a replacement for this item. The data or the rights to use the data needed to purchase these parts from additional sources are not owned by the Government and it is not economical to purchase them. Lockheed Martin (LM) is the Original Equipment Supplier, design agent, and system integrator for the Q-70 weapon system. LM has the expert knowledge of the design and operational characteristics of this weapon system, to include various configurations on multiple platforms, which includes Maritime, Air and Land-based applications. LM is the only source possessing the expertise on critical engineering processes, procedures, software, firmware, components and test fixtures to ensure the appropriate configuration for compatibility within the Q-70 system. LM has an established supplier base consisting of more than 70 COTS/NDI product lines. This expertise and engineering knowledge cannot be readily duplicated without significant time and cost associated with re-engineering, which would result in programmatic risk to Navy Combat Systems equipment and schedules.

6. GOVERNMENTWIDE POINT OF ENTRY NOTICE/POTENTIAL SOURCES: A presolicitation notice to inform potential sources of this impending requirement was posted to the GPE in accordance with FAR 5.2 on 10 Mar 2016. The solicitation was also posted to the GPE in accordance with FAR 5.2 on 29 Mar 2016. This justification and the resultant award will be posted to FedBizOpps in accordance with FAR 5.3.

7. DETERMINATION OF FAIR AND REASONABLE COST: The contracting officer determines that the anticipated cost to the Government will be fair and reasonable. In instances when certified cost and pricing data are required, an analysis of cost information will be performed which will consider field pricing reports, commerciality, procurement history and other available cost and pricing information in determining price reasonableness. When certified cost and pricing data is obtained it will be used to ensure reasonableness, completeness and realism of proposed costs as required.

8. DESCRIPTION OF MARKET SURVEY: A technical review, which consisted of searching several Government databases including ITIMP, NSSP and ERP, and JEDMICS and NSEDR has been completed on this item. Search criteria included Part Number, Design Control Activity, Cage Code, NSN, Nomenclature, AMC/AMSC, AAC, Criticality Coding, recorded approved sources of supply, historical sources of supply and past contracts. Based on this market research the contracting officer has determined that the only known manufacturing source is 52088. ERP Master Data Base and HAYSTACK data bases were queried through item interrogation to ascertain potential alternate sources that may be identified that would meet the Government's minimum requirements for the tasks. At this time no additional sources were identified through these research efforts. Furthermore, a Sources Sought Base Notice was posted to FedBizOpps on 5 February 2016 for 10 calendar days, inviting potential sources to fill out a Market Survey and express their interest in providing an offer on this order to be forwarded to the design and technical authority for approval. DRS Technologies and Koehlke Components, Inc submitted responses to the market survey. DRS Technologies and Koehlke Components, Inc information was forwarded to NAVSEA to determine what ISEA will do the review since Q-70 is an "orphaned" system and does not have a centralized program office or in-service engineering activity (ISEA). The current procurement will not be delayed

while the ISEA conducts their review and makes a final determination if DRS and Koehlke can be approved as a source of supply for future requirements.

9. ANY OTHER SUPPORTING FACTS:

Drawings are not available for full and open competition. The data or the rights to use the data needed to purchase these items from alternate sources are not owned by the Government and it is not economical to purchase them.

11. ACTIONS TO REMOVE BARRIERS TO COMPETITION: The government will include a clause in the solicitation that provides that the government will consider alternate offers, and that alternate offerors should submit a source approval request (SAR) package that will be referred to the NAVSUPWSS technical division for review. Q-70 is an "orphaned" system so it no longer has a centralized program office or in-service engineering activity (ISEA). Alternate offers submitted may be forwarded to NAVSEA, SPAWAR and the NAVAIR Host Program Offices as appropriate. If due to mission requirements the current procurement cannot be delayed in order to allow sufficient time for approval of alternate offers, the SAR package will be considered for future awards.


