



1. IDENTIFICATION OF AGENCY AND/OR CONTRACTING ACTIVITY: DLA Philadelphia /

2. NATURE/DESCRIPTION OF ACTION: This J&A is for the negotiation and award of a contract through other than full and open competition.



4. IDENTIFICATION OF STATUTORY AUTHORITY: This J&A is based upon the authority of 10 USC 2304(c)(1), as implemented by Federal Acquisition Regulation 6.302.1



6. **FEDERAL BUSINESS OPPORTUNITIES/POTENTIAL SOURCES:** The proposed contract was/will be synopsized in the FedBizOpps website for government wide point of entry.

7. **DETERMINATION OF FAIR AND REASONABLE COST:** The contracting officer determines that the anticipated cost to the Government will be fair and reasonable. In instances when certified cost and pricing are required, an analysis of cost information will be performed which will consider field pricing reports, commerciality, procurement history and other available cost and pricing information in determining reasonableness. Certified cost and pricing data will be obtained and used to ensure reasonableness, completeness and realism of proposed costs as required.

8. **DESCRIPTION OF MARKET SURVEY:** A technical review has been made to determine and identify all known sources.

9. **ANY OTHER SUPPORTING FACTS:** The articles to be procured are complex and must meet critical operational and reliability requirements, the achievement of which requires unique production techniques and extensive and/or sophisticated testing, and the government has not yet acquired or developed the technical data.

11. **ACTIONS TO REMOVE BARRIERS TO COMPETITION:** The Naval Inventory Control Point, Source Development Department has a breakout program designed to convert as many acquisitions as possible to full and open competition. However, the items that are to be procured under this acquisition are for Interim Supply Support (ISS) of the EP-3E ESM/DF/RFD trays. ISS items are considered design unstable as no formal configuration baseline has been established. Since the Material Support Date (MSD) is scheduled for 1 Sept 2012, reprourement technical data has not yet been developed, and will not be available in time to support Initial Operating Capability (IOC). It is anticipated that technical data will be provided to the Navy at a later date, at which time the technical data will be evaluated to determine if it is suitable for competition, as well as evaluating the feasibility of any other alternatives for achieving and/or enhancing, competition.






