4. **IDENTIFICATION OF STATUTORY AUTHORITY:** This J&A is based upon the authority of 10 USC 2304(c)(1), as implemented by Federal Acquisition Regulation 6.302.1

5. **DEMONSTRATION OF CONTRACTORS UNIQUE QUALIFICATIONS:** The current Acquisition Method Code (AMC/AMSC) is 3C. This acquisition will be negotiated with BELL HELICOPTER TEXTRON INC (97499)

Only the above will be solicited because the articles to be acquired are highly specialized parts, designed and manufactured by a non-Government activity and the technical data required for acquisition by other than the above is not available.

6. **FEDERAL BUSINESS OPPORTUNITIES/POTENTIAL SOURCES:** The proposed contract was/will be synopsisized in the FedBizOpps website for government wide point of entry.

7. **DETERMINATION OF FAIR AND REASONABLE COST:** The contracting officer determines that the anticipated cost to the Government will be fair and reasonable. In instances when certified cost and pricing are required, an analysis of cost information will be performed which will consider field pricing reports, commerciality, procurement history and other available cost and pricing information in determining reasonableness. The articles to be procured are complex and must meet critical operational and reliability requirements, the achievement of which requires unique production techniques and extensive and/or sophisticated testing, and the government has not yet acquired or developed the technical data.

10. **LISTING OF INTERESTED SOURCES:** The following sources have expressed, in writing, an interest in this acquisition.

11. **ACTIONS TO REMOVE BARRIERS TO COMPETITION:**

The NAVSUP Weapons Systems Support Source Development Department has completed a full screen review on the subject item. The AMC/AMSC is (3C) with Bell helicopter Textron (97499) as the only approved source of supply. No other sources have expressed an interest in manufacturing the subject item to the Source Development Department. Available data has not been found adequate to support competitive acquisition. Additional sources must obtain engineering source approval prior to contract award. NAVSUP will continue to encourage manufacturers with the expertise to manufacture the subject item to submit a complete technical data package for review and source approval by the appropriate engineering source approval authority. Future requirements will continue to be advertised in the FedBizOpps website ([www.fedbizopps.gov](http://www.fedbizopps.gov)) and in the NAVSUP Buy Requirements Listings. *JPB*


