5. **DEMONSTRATION OF CONTRACTORS UNIQUE QUALIFICATIONS:** The current Acquisition Method Code (AMC/AMSC) is 3H. This acquisition will be negotiated with

Only the above will be solicited because the articles to be acquired are highly specialized parts, designed and manufactured by a non-Government activity and the technical data required for acquisition by other than the above is not available.

6. **FEDERAL BUSINESS OPPORTUNITIES/POTENTIAL SOURCES:** The proposed contract was/will be synopsized in the FedBizOpps website for government wide point of entry.
7. **DETERMINATION OF FAIR AND REASONABLE COST:** The contracting officer determines that the anticipated cost to the Government will be fair and reasonable. 9. **ANY OTHER SUPPORTING FACTS:** The articles to be procured are complex and must meet critical operational and reliability requirements, the achievement of which requires unique production techniques and extensive and/or sophisticated testing, and the government has not yet acquired or developed the technical data.
10. **LISTING OF INTERESTED SOURCES:** The following sources have expressed, in writing, an interest in this acquisition.
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11. **ACTIONS TO REMOVE BARRIERS TO COMPETITION:** The FedBizOpps website (www.fedbizopps.gov) is the primary means of articulating Government requirements to industry. To increase competition, it advertises the requirements of NAVICP to encourage potential sources to submit source approval requests for flight critical items. The subject item is flight critical and requires approval of any additional sources prior to award. As a result, any additional source expressing an interest in becoming an approved source will be encouraged to seek qualification via NAVICP's Source Approval process. The submission of source approval requests will be evaluated and processed to NAVAIR for final review. Future requirements will continue to be advertised in the FedBizOpps and Buy Requirements Listing to encourage submission of Source Approval Requests.
