16. Title of the proposed contract action: Regional Hazardous Waste Management Services

The Department of Navy, Naval Facilities Engineering Command (NAVFAC) Washington, intends to solicit for a REGIONAL HAZARDOUS WASTE MANAGEMENT SERVICES contract within the National Capital Region.

The contract is planned as a combination Firm Fixed Price/ Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity (FFP/IDIQ) type contract. The contract will be for a base period and four one-year option periods that cumulatively will not exceed sixty (60) months.

The best value procurement will require both technical and cost proposals. Award will be based on the best value to the Government; price and technical factors will be considered. All technical evaluation factors are considered equal of importance to one another, and when combined are approximately equal to price. Please refer to Sections L & M of the solicitation for details regarding the evaluation criteria and submission requirements. The specific evaluation factors will be included in the Request for Proposal. The Government may award the contract without conducting discussions; therefore the offeror's initial proposal shall contain its best terms from a

cost and technical standpoint. The Government reserves the right to enter into discussions if deemed necessary to obtain the best value for the Government.

Information for this requirement and solicitation package with specifications will be listed under solicitation number N40080-10-R-0460 on approximately February 6, 2011, with all files posted on the Government Wide Point of Entry Navy Electronic Commerce Online (NECO) at <http://www.neco.navy.mil>. The solicitation will be available in electronic format only. Contractors are encouraged to register for the solicitation when downloading from NECO. Only registered contractors will be notified by email when amendments to the solicitation are issued. All documents will be in the Adobe Acrobat PDF file format via the Internet. Interested parties must be registered in the Central Contractor Registry (CCR) as prescribed in FAR Clause 52.232-33 and DFARS 252.204-7004. Lack of registration in the CCR database on the part of the offeror will make an offeror ineligible for award. The work includes, but is not limited to: The Contractor shall provide all labor, management, supervision, tools, material, supplies, vehicles, and equipment required to perform environmental services including but not limited to hazardous waste management and operations within the National Capital Region, which includes, but is not limited to: hazardous waste management operations, watch-standers for specific Navy sites, spill containment, spill control, materials cleanup and removal, and hazardous material (HM) / hazardous waste (HW) / regulated waste (RW) transport.

Procurement Method: Contracting by Negotiation

The North American Industry Classification Standard (NAICS) Code for this procurement is 562112 and the annual size standard is \$12.5 million.

The contract term will be a base period of one year plus four option years. Only the base period of the contract will offer a minimum guarantee. If the Government does not award a follow-on contract in time, the Government may require the Contractor to continue performance for an additional period up to six months under the Option to Extend Services clause.

This contract will replace two current contracts for similar services. One was awarded in 2007 with a maximum current contract value of \$3.3M, including IDIQ estimates. The second one was awarded in 2009, with a maximum current contract value of \$2.6M, including IDIQ estimates. Information about the current contract and the incumbent contractor (e.g., value of last option exercised, firm name, address, etc.) will be included in the solicitation package. Requests under the Freedom of Information Act are not required for this information.

The proposed contract listed here is 100 percent small business set-aside. The Government will only accept offers from small business concerns.

The solicitation utilizes source selection procedures which require offerors to submit a technical proposal, past performance and experience information, safety information, and a price (or cost) proposal for evaluation by the Government.

17. Place of contract performance: The work under this contract will be performed predominately in the Navy activities in support of the Commander, Navy Installations Command (CNIC), within a 100-mile radius of the National Capital Region including but not limited to: The Washington Navy Yard, Washington, DC; National Naval Medical Center (NNMC), Bethesda, MD; Naval Support Facility (NSF) Anacostia, Washington, DC; NSF Naval Observatory, Washington, DC; NSF Suitland, MD; NSF Arlington, VA; Washington Headquarters Services – Pentagon, VA; NSF Carderock, MD; Naval Air Station Patuxent River, MD; NSF Indian Head, MD; NSF Dahlgren, VA; NSF Stump Neck, MD; NSF Webster Field, MD; NSF Solomon's, MD; and NSA Annapolis, MD. Some locations may require that the Service Provider's employees and subcontractors shall maintain TS/SCI Level Clearances.
