1.1 The Offeror is required to submit as its proposal the following:

(X) Offeror shall submit three separate volumes:

- **Volume I: Price Proposal** - Offerors shall submit, at a minimum, the following information in the price proposal in accordance with the Governments desired pricing terms and conditions. A current listing of Government vehicles is provided as Attachment I for reference.

Offerors demonstrating significant, relevant experience with specific requirements set forth in the PWS will be evaluated most favorably. Offerors demonstrating less significant and less relevant experience with the requirements in the PWS will be evaluated less favorably.

Offerors are directed to provide Contractor Performance Data Sheets on no more than 5 of the Offeror's most recently completed, or currently on-going, Federal Government or Commercial contracts, not to exceed 3 years since completion for like or similar services to those to be provided under this solicitation. Offerors may submit performance data regarding current contract performance as long as a minimum of 1 year of performance has been completed as of the closing date of this solicitation.

The offeror has both the duty and discretion to determine which of its prior contracts are most relevant to the currently described requirements. However, the offeror should consider that the Government shall give special attention to past performance relating to the United States Federal Government. Commercial contracts will be considered.

If the offeror is unable to provide 5 relevant contracts for the past performance evaluation, a lesser number may be submitted.

The offeror may also submit relevant contracts performed by subcontractors that will perform under this contract, but under no circumstances may an offeror submit more than 5 contracts for review, regardless of whether the contracts were performed by the offeror, subcontractor(s), or any combination thereof. **BPA TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

**BLANKET PURCHASE AGREEMENT (BPA) BASIC TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

- 1.0 The U.S. Government intends to establish a Blanket Purchase Agreement (BPA) with one or more responsible companies that can supply required vehicle rehabilitation/repair services. Establishment of a BPA will be based on certifications and past performance factors presented by the Contractor. Discussions may be held with companies if there is a need to do so. Contractors are advised that while the Government may establish multiple BPAs, we will only establish the number of BPAs believed to be sufficient to meet our needs and regulatory competition requirements.
- 1.1 A BPA is an Agreement, not a contract, and neither party is bound by its terms and conditions. The Government is not obligated to purchase any definite amount under this BPA. If a need arises, an authorized representative of the Government may issue a call order following the procedures outlined in the BPA. If the BPA-holder accepts the order, then a binding contract between the Government and BPA-holder will exist for that specific order. If the BPA-holder refuses to accept orders or furnish quotations in compliance with the terms of the Agreement, then the Government reserves the right to cancel the Agreement with that BPA-holder.
- 1.2 The Government shall only be obligated to the extent of authorized purchases actually made under this BPA. The BPA-holder shall not provide supplies or perform any work without a BPA Call Order issued to the BPA-holder by an authorized ordering official.
- 2.0 **PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE:** The effective date of this BPA shall be for a five (5) year period from the date of establishment. This Agreement will remain in effect until terminated by either party.
- 2.1 Completion of BPA: A BPA is considered complete when all authorized purchases made under it equal its total maximum dollar limitation, if any, when its stated time period expires or in the event it is cancelled by either party.
- 2.2 Purchases under this BPA: The limitation for the total value of all call orders placed under this BPA is set at \$600,000.00.
- 2.3 This BPA shall be reviewed on an annual basis prior to the anniversary date of BPA establishment. The Contracting Officer shall conduct an annual review of BPA Call Orders placed under this BPA in accordance with FAR 13.303-6 so that the Contracting Officer can:
- Ensure proper procedures are being followed by the authorized callers.
  - Award new BPAs if changes in the market conditions, such as pricing, have occurred;
  - Discontinue the BPA with companies to whom orders have not been issued;
  - Update the BPA if necessary.
- 3.0 **VEHICLE REHABILITATION/REPAIR SERVICES PRICING:**
- 3.1 The price for all vehicle rehabilitation/repair services shall be established based on the Contractors commercial pricing arrangements and applicable discounts.
- 3.2 The Contractor shall provide vehicle rehabilitation/repair services to the Government at those prices provided its most favorable customers, or lower discounts. A current listing of Government vehicles in need of rehabilitation/repair is provided as Attachment I for reference.
- 4.0 **DEFINITIONS:**
- 4.1 **AUTHORIZED CALLERS:** Authorized individuals appointed by the BPA Contracting Officer can place BPA calls. Authorized callers are listed in this agreement and also shall be identified by separate letter that will establish their authorized dollar limits for calls placed. (otherwise known as Ordering Officers)

- 4.2 **CONTRACTING OFFICER**: US Government Official authorized to enter into, make changes to, or terminate contracts on behalf of the US Government. Contracting Officers are responsible for ensuring performance of all necessary actions for effective contracting, ensuring compliance with the terms of the contract, and safeguarding the interests of the United States in its contractual relationships.
- 4.3 **CONTRACTING OFFICER'S REPRESENTATIVE (COR)**: The COR is the Contracting Officer's direct liaison between himself and the Contractor on any matter dealing with the technical aspects of performance under an order placed against this Blanket Purchase Agreement. The COR will ensure that the Contractor performs in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Blanket Purchase Agreement.
- 4.4 **CONTRACTOR**: The BPA-Holder upon issuance of an individual BPA Call Order against this BPA is referred to as the Contractor under the individual BPA Call Order.
- 4.5 **MICRO PURCHASE THRESHOLD**: The Micro Purchase Threshold is currently \$3,000.00
- 4.6 **ORDERING OFFICER (OO)**: An ordering officer has, within the limits of assigned authority, the ability to sign, issue, and modify BPA Call Orders under this Blanket Purchase Agreements.
- 4.7 **QUALITY ASSURANCE**: Those actions taken by the Government to check goods or services to determine that they meet the requirements of the Performance Work Statement (PWS).
- 4.8 **QUALITY ASSURANCE REPRESENTATIVE (QAR)**: The Government liaison, which functions as the technical representative monitoring, delivery and performance of orders placed against this Blanket Purchase Agreement. The QAR is not authorized to enter into discussion with the Contractor concerning the accuracy of the Government inspection actions nor the validity of his contractual interpretations QAR information shall be provided for each separate BPA Call Order placed against this Blanket Purchase Agreement.
- 5.0 GENERAL ORDERING GUIDELINES:**
- 5.1 If more than one vendor has received an Agreement for vehicle rehabilitation/repair services, the following guidelines shall apply.
- 5.2 Only Ordering Officers (OO) appointed by the Contracting Officer of the Regional Contracting Office (RCO) shall be authorized to place call orders against the BPA. A listing of Ordering Officers authorized to place calls against this BPA shall be provided upon establishment of the BPA. The Government will update the list as authorizations change.
- 5.3 As the need for services arise, the Government will develop a price estimate. No matter the price of the estimate, the Government will follow the procedures in paragraph (a) below.
- (a) All Orders – The Government will compete the orders among the BPA holders that can perform the required services by:
- (i) Requesting each BPA-holder to provide, AT NO COST TO THE GOVERNMENT, a quotation. Whether or not the BPA-holder is selected for an individual order, the Government shall not be liable for any claim from the BPA-holder for the cost of providing the quote.
- (ii) Select the Contractor that presents the best value to the Government. Selection may be based on estimated price, delivery time, and past performance information or a combination of these. Evaluation criteria for each individual BPA call: Price, Delivery time, and Past performance will be the most commonly used factors utilized to evaluate a Contractor's quotations.
- (iii) All BPA Calls exceeding US \$3,000 will be issued by the Contracting Officer.

5.4 The Government shall assign an individualized call number to each order for services. Call numbers shall not be repeated throughout the life of the BPA. All Calls shall be in written form with confirmation from the Authorized Caller on date of issuance and acceptance from the Contractor.

5.5 The Contractor shall prepare a delivery ticket for each call placed. The delivery ticket shall be prepared in triplicate and shall include the following information:

- (a) Name of Supplier
- (b) BPA Master Number
- (c) Individual BPA Call Number
- (d) Date of Call and Name of BPA Ordering Officer

**PERFORMANCE WORK STATEMENT  
VEHICLE REHABILITATION/ACCIDENT REPAIRS**

**1.0 Scope of Work:** The contractor shall provide all qualified personnel, supervision, supplies, materials, parts, components, equipment, tools, and transportation to perform rehabilitation/repair services for Government owned vehicles (see Attachment I for current listing) located at the Camp Foster Maintenance facility Building # 5822. Work shall be performed at the Contractor's facility.

**2.0 General Task:** It shall be the Contractor's sole responsibility to perform all work under the contract in compliance with the most current edition/revision of the Japanese Environmental Governing Standards (JEGS). The Contractor shall strictly adhere to all JEGS requirements regarding maintenance services. The Contractor shall be responsible to pick up and deliver the vehicle.

**2.1 Specific Task:**

2.1.1 Contractor shall perform rehabilitation-overhaul/accident repairs that includes specified component replacements, preventative maintenance, repair services, purchase of required materials, replacement of parts, installation, inspection, and removal of old or defective parts, cleaning, painting, priming, rust prohibitive, undercoating, lubricating, adjusting, and testing to ensure replaced equipment is fully operational according to the manufacturer's original specifications. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Replace or repair all broken or unsalvageable vehicle body parts.
- Remove old paint, primer, rust prohibitive and rust from body and frame down to bare metal.
- Replace with same gauge metal.
- Perform body work as required using bond and sanding to a smooth surface. Removal of all rust.
- Re-apply new primer, rust prohibitive and two coats of paint.
- Apply Ziebart or Ziebart equivalent rust prohibitive undercoating to entire frame to include the lifting bed rails.

2.1.2 The Contractor shall thoroughly inspect all equipment parts for deterioration, excessive wear, misalignment, loose joints, improper adjustments, or any other defects that affect machine operability, and correct them in accordance with the manufacturer's specifications.

**3.0 General Information:**

**3.1 Place of performance:** Overhaul /repairs will be performed at the Contractor's work site.

**3.2 Period of performance:** All work will be completed within 20 days after receipt of each order.

**3.3 Contract Manager:** The Contractor shall provide a Contract Manager who shall be responsible for coordinating the performance of the work and act as a point of contact for any inquiries regarding the status of the repairs. The name of this person and an alternate, who shall act on behalf of the Contractor when the Manager is absent, shall be designated in writing to the Contracting Officer.

3.3.1 The Contract Manager shall have full authority to act on behalf of the Contractor on all contract matters relating to the daily operation of this BPA.

3.3.2 The Contract Manager, or alternate shall be available during normal duty hours, within one workday, to meet on with Government personnel to discuss problem areas.

3.3.3 The Contract Manager and alternate shall be able to read, write, speak and understand English.

**4.0 Warranty:** In addition to the implied warranty specified at FAR 52.212-4 (o) and any manufacturer’s warranty, the Contractor shall warrant the vehicle rehabilitation/repair for a minimum of 90 days after the acceptance of the services.

**5.0 Quality Assurance:** Will be recorded by the Garrison Mobile Equipment Supply Section throughout the life cycle of the agreement to reflect the failure and/or success rate of the services received.

**6.0 Period of Performance:** The effective date of this BPA shall be for a five (5) year period from the date of establishment. This Agreement will remain in effect until terminated by either party.

**7.0 Hours of Operation**

**7.1 Regular Working Hours:** The Government’s representatives regular working hours are from 07:30 to 16:30 Hours, Monday through Friday.

**7.1.1 Recognized Holidays:** The contractor is not required to provide service on the following Federal Holidays\*.

The Contractor shall depart military bases when TCCOR One-Caution (1C) or TC-1C is declared by Military Weather Station authorities. The Contractor shall depart military bases and monitor radio/television until it changes to TCCOR Storm Watch (SW) or TC-SW. When TC-SW is declared by Military Weather Station authorities, the Contractor may restart service within 2 hours. In the case where TC-SW is called after normal hours of operation, services shall begin the next normal workday at 07:30 am.

52.209-5 CERTIFICATION REGARDING RESPONSIBILITY MATTERS (APR 2010)

(a)(1) The Offeror certifies, to the best of its knowledge and belief, that-

(i) The Offeror and/or any of its Principals-

(A) Are ( ) are not ( ) presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, or declared ineligible for the award of contracts by any Federal agency;

Vehicle permits may be issued to civilian Contractors for the duration of their contract, until expiration of base pass or vehicle inspection, whichever occurs first or until termination of their employment. Included in vehicle permit requests shall be the license number, year, make, model, color, and operator's name for each vehicle. Any disagreement arising under this contract which is not resolved by the parties to this contract may be submitted to the U.S. Japan Joint Committee for Conciliation in accordance with paragraph 10, Article XVIII, of the Status of Forces agreement under Article VI, of the Treaty of Mutual Cooperation and security between Japan and the United States of America.

Recourse to the Joint Committee for Conciliation for resolving disputes is available in addition to the procedures set forth in the Contract Disputes Act of 1978 and the Disputes Clause of this contract, 52.233-1. A request for conciliation by the Joint Committee, however, shall not toll the time periods allowed under the Contract Disputes Act for appealing a counteracting officer's final decision to either the Armed Services Board of Contract Appeals or U.S. Court of Federal Claims.

Upon filing a request for conciliation with the joint Committee, the Contractor shall immediately notify the Contracting Officer in writing of the request.

CLAUSES INCORPORATED BY FULL TEXT

**PHYSICAL SECURITY**

Contractor shall be responsible for safeguarding all government property provided for Contractor use. At the close of each work period, government facilities, equipment, and materials shall be secured, and utilities turned off or set for conservation.

**INFORMATION SECURITY**

The Contractor shall keep the customer's transaction confidential and not disclose any information pertaining to the customer without permission, except that required by management information reports, including such information as may be needed by the Marine Corps to audit or monitor services rendered, prices charged, concession fees paid, etc.
