SOLICITATION NOTES:

1. **NOTE:** This acquisition is restricted to qualified sources. A qualification package is required for new sources. See FAR Clause 52.209-1 for qualification requirements. Potential vendors must first pre-qualify before any offers will be considered. Prospective contractors may submit offers on supplies bearing different part numbers from those cited in the solicitation. Proposals will not be delayed to qualify new sources.
2. Faxed offers will NOT be accepted.
3. This item is a CSI – Critical Safety Item.
4. Electronic submission of an offer may be accomplished by attaching your offer to an email directed to stacey.romberger@navy.mil. The size limitation of an email through the NAVSUP WSS mail server is 10 MB. All files designated as .zip files will be stripped from any email sent. Files larger than the server limitation may be segregated and sent via several emails as long as they are clearly identified as such.
5. The contractor is the exporter of record.
6. Waivers to DFARS 252.223-7002 are shown as waiver numbers 1 through 18. The contractor shall comply with all other requirements of DFARS 252.223-7002 that is not waived below.

The specific requirements to be waived for Martin-Baker Aircraft Company only are numbered 1 through 5 and are as follows:

1. Use of catch or splash pans (*Safety Manual Reference: C3.5.4*)

Waiver: MBA hereby requests a waiver from the use of catch or splash pans to prevent spillage of explosives and other hazardous materials.

2. Use of water in containers for black powder (*Safety Manual Reference: C3.6.3*)

Waiver: MBA hereby requests a waiver from the requirement that containers for scrap black powder and similar materials should contain water.

3. Marking of containers of explosives waste (*Safety Manual Reference: C3.14.2*)

Waiver: MBA hereby requests a waiver from the requirement for explosives waste containers to be marked with the hazard division and quantity of explosive.

4. Use of glass containers (*Safety Manual Reference: C3.14.3*)

Waiver: MBA hereby requests a waiver from the restriction on the use of glass containers for explosives.

5. In-process quantities and storage (*Safety Manual Reference: C7.T1*)

Waiver: MBA hereby requests a waiver from the mandatory requirement for remote controls for machining of propellant of HD1.3 defined within table C7.T1.

The specific requirements to be waived for Martin-Baker Aircraft Company and their UK subcontractors are numbered 6 through 18 and are as follows:

6. Quantity Distances (*Safety Manual Reference: Appendix 2.*)

Waiver: MBA hereby requests a waiver recognizing the specifically identified pre-existing condition of our facility, and our subcontractors' facilities in the UK, that the applicable QD distances shall be as defined within UK Explosives Regulations 2014.

7. Site Plans (*Safety Manual Reference: C1.8.1, C1.8.3 & C1.8.4.*)

Waiver: MBA hereby requests a waiver that site plans shall conform with UK Explosives Regulations 2014.

Waiver: MBA hereby requests a waiver from submitting site plans to the ACO. Site plans shall be available for review during pre-award safety surveys by the relevant DCMA Safety Representative.

Waiver: MBA hereby requests a waiver from submitting site plans for new construction or major modifications.

8. General safety requirements (*Safety Manual Reference: C3.1*)

Waiver: MBA hereby requests a waiver that in the unlikely event of a direct conflict between local/national regulations and the Safety Manual, that local/national regulations shall take precedence.

9. Calculation of reduced QDs. (*Safety Manual Reference: C5.12*)

Waiver: MBA hereby requests a waiver from the requirement to demonstrate reduced or eliminated explosive effects for reduced QDs.

10. Facilities siting criteria (*Safety Manual Reference: C5.18*)

Waiver: MBA hereby requests a waiver from the Safety Manual Facilities Siting Criteria.

11. Electrical installations (*Safety Manual Reference: C6.2*)

Waiver: MBA hereby requests a waiver that recognizes that the standards that shall be applied for electrical installations shall be the relevant British or European standard in lieu of those within the Safety Manual.

12. US National Fire Protection Association guidelines (*Safety Manual Reference: C6.2.1 and Reference (r).*)

Waiver: MBA hereby requests a waiver from the requirements contained within the NFPA Standard 70 at reference (r) of the Safety Manual. National regulations and agreement with local fire authorities shall apply in lieu of this reference.

13. Static electricity and grounding (*Safety Manual Reference: C6.4*)

Waiver: MBA hereby requests a waiver from the Safety Manual provisions for Static Electricity and Grounding on the basis that operators in the UK shall comply with UK Explosives Regulations, and that applicable British/European standards shall apply in lieu.

Waiver: MBA hereby requests a specific waiver from the threshold of 0.1J electrostatic sensitivity of explosives requiring a conductive regime. The threshold under UK legislation is 1mJ. (C6.4.7 and C6.4.8).

14. Use of DoD Hazard Divisions (*Safety Manual Reference: C9.2.2*)

Waiver: MBA hereby requests a waiver from the use of DoD Hazard Divisions. The use of UN Hazard Divisions is mandated under UK Explosives Regulations.

15. Portable fire extinguishers (*Safety Manual Reference: C10.5*)

Waiver: MBA hereby requests a waiver from the quoted NFPA standard No. 10 - reference (v). The equivalent UK standards BS5306 Part 3 and BS 6643 Part 1 shall apply in lieu of reference (v).

16. Fire hazard identification system (*Safety Manual Reference: C10.6*)

Waiver: MBA hereby requests a waiver from the mandatory use of fire division markings on storage buildings.

17. Firebreaks (*Safety Manual Reference: C10.10*)

Waiver: MBA hereby requests a waiver from the requirement for firebreaks in all directions around magazines and AE operating buildings.

18. AE Building Design and Layout (*Safety Manual Reference: C12*)

Waiver: MBA hereby requests a waiver from the Safety Manual AE Building Design and Layout requirements, on the basis that UK Explosives Regulations shall apply in lieu.
