2. Description of the Action Being Approved

This is a sole source action submitted for approval to award a Firm Fixed Priced contract for the procurement and installation of replacement stands for the existing Audio Visual (AV) and Video Teleconference (VTC) system required by Naval Cyber Defense Operations Command (NCDOC) located in Suffolk, VA. This requirement will be awarded subject to FAR 13.5 – "Test Program for Certain Commercial Items."

3. Description of Supplies/Services

NCDOC requires the procurement and installation of replacement projector stands. The existing stands were installed by previous tenant, and are required to support two 275 pound projectors on each stand. Currently the system is requiring constant adjustments as that the current stands are just not stable enough to prevent motion interfering with the projected display. Since the display is designed to produce one contiguous image from multiple projections, the current setup is not fully operational as it stands. Required delivery date is nine months after delivery of contract. Fiscal Year 2015 Operations and Maintenance, Navy (O&M,N) funds have been provided.

4. Statutory Authority Permitting Other Than Full and Open Competition

The statutory authority for this action is Section 4202 of the Clinger-Cohen Act of 1996, a sole source acquisition under the authority of the test program for certain commercial items, as implemented by Federal Acquisition Regulation FAR 13.501(a).

5. Rationale Justifying Use of Cited Statutory Authority

The proposed sole source requirement is to acquire necessary schematics and configuration codes for an existing AV system previously installed/written by Mechdyne Corporation for Joint Staff who was utilizing the facility in 2011. Since that time, NCDOC has moved into the space and has taken over the use of the existing equipment. NCDOC requires reconfiguration of the system to meet day-to-day mission requirements. As no known schematic and configuration code documentation currently exists, Mechdyne Corporation is the only known vendor with the requisite knowledge of the codes and schematics of the system to reconfigure the system once it is put back into place on the new platforms. No

other vendor can provide the required support without significant research and discovery costs and an increased downtime of the video wall system.

6. Description of Efforts Made to Solicit Offers from as Many Offerors as Practicable

This requirement will be synopsised and the solicitation will be posted on the Navy Electronic Commerce Online (NECO) website.

7. Determination of Fair and Reasonable Cost

The Procuring Contracting Officer will make a determination of fair and reasonableness of price based upon price analysis in accordance with FAR 13.106-3.

8. Actions to Remove Barriers to Future Competition

NCDOC has determined the correct specifications that will fully stabilize the projectors and will not require additional stabilization and/or replacement in the future.
