2. Description of the Action Being Approved

This is a brand name action for approval to award a firm-fixed-price (FFP) contract for commercial supplies limited to Ultra Electronics Advanced Tactical Systems as required by Center for Surface Combat Systems (CSCS). CSCS requires an Air Defense Systems Integrator (ADSI) to replace an existing ADSI machine that is no longer supported by Ultra Electronics in the AEGIS Readiness and Training Center (ARTC).

3. Description of the Action Being Approved

CSCS requires a new ADSI system at the ARTC as it is the same equipment used throughout the Joint and Fleet concentration areas. Currently, there are no other systems that integrate with ADSI and as such, the systems taught at the ARTC must be the same as those used after their training is completed. The ADSI allows for tactical data to track upwards of 16,000 aircraft through digital air control through TacView software, enables for 32 different simulations, and facilitates communication between ADSI command and control systems and other ADSI command and control systems. 4. **IDENTIFICATION OF STATUTORY AUTHORITY:**

The statutory authority of this action is 41 U.S.C. 1901, a brand name acquisition under the authority of the simplified procedures for certain commercial items, as implemented by FAR 13.501(a).

5. **DEMONSTRATION OF CONTRACTOR'S UNIQUE QUALIFICATIONS:**

CSCS is responsible to develop and deliver surface ship combat systems training to achieve surface warfare superiority. Further, at the ATRC, it is their mission to provide enlisted personnel with the knowledge, ability, and skill to operate and maintain the AEGIS Combat System through timely, effective, and integrated training delivered across the Sailors' careers. In order to successfully meet their mission requirements, ATRC must provide sailor's with training on the systems they will operate in the fleet forces. As the ADSI system is the current system utilized within the fleet, it is the only system that ATRC can train sailors on. The Navy has spent tens of millions of dollars on equipment and training of the ADSI throughout the fleet, therefore, ATRC must continue to train all sailors to use those existing systems.

6. **DESCRIPTION OF EFFORTS MADE TO SOLICIT OFFERS FROM AS MANY OFFERORS AS PRACTICABLE:**

This requirement will be synopsisized and the solicitation will be posted on the Navy Electronic Commerce Online (NECO) website.

7. **DETERMINATION OF FAIR AND REASONABLE COST:**

A determination of fairness and reasonableness of price will be based on the Procuring Contracting Officer's price analysis of the contractor's quote in accordance with FAR 13.106-3.

8. **ACTIONS TAKEN TO REMOVE BARRIERS TO COMPETITION:**

For the reasons set forth in Paragraph 5, NAVSUP FLCN has no plans at this time to compete future contracts for the types of supplies covered by this document. Market research will be performed to ascertain if another source exists for future requirements.
