

Subject: Issuance of a Basic Ordering Agreement, and delivery orders thereunder, for repair of various items in support of the P-8 platform.

This is a combined synopsis and sources sought notice. Naval Supply Systems Command Weapon Systems Support (NAVSUP WSS) Philadelphia intends to solicit Hamilton Sundstrand Corporation (99167) located in Rockford, IL for repair of 18 items in support of the P-8 Aircraft under the authority of Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) 6.302-1, "Only one responsible source and no other supplies or services will satisfy agency requirements." Hamilton Sundstrand Corporation is the only known source that can perform repairs on these items. Suitable technical data and Government data rights are not available to permit repair by other sources. The estimated award date for this BOA is December 2016. The contemplated duration of the BOA is five years.

The applicable NAICS code for the above items is 336413, 332919, 333412 and 335999. Three (3) items under this acquisition are subject to the Trade Agreements Act and/or the World Trade Organization Government Procurement Agreement and Free Trade Agreements.

While the government only currently has the above-named source for repair of these items, potential interest in such repairs by other sources is welcome, subject to the following conditions. Since technical data for such repairs is proprietary to the current source and unavailable to the government to disseminate, any other source will have to obtain the required technical data. In addition, because the items are considered critical to flight/mission (critical application items), any other interested sources will be required to submit and have approved a Source Approval

Request (SAR) package in order to be eligible for repair work for these items. A SAR brochure describing the process for SAR submission and approval is available at https://www.navsup.navy.mil/navsup/ourteam/navsupwss/business_opps. It should also be noted as to this contemplated repair BOA and delivery orders, in the event a source were to obtain technical data necessary for repairs from the current repair source, the time required for approval of a new source is normally such that award cannot be delayed pending approval of a new source. Thus SAR approval, if received, may be useable for future repair requirements for these items.
