JUSTIFICATION AND APPROVAL FOR USE OF OTHER THAN FULL AND OPEN COMPETITION

1. Contracting Activity.

NAVSUP Fleet Logistics Center Puget Sound

2. Description of Action Being Approved.

Award of a contract on a sole source basis to Abbott Laboratories, Diagnostics Division to provide annual maintenance services for the Abbott Prism Next system located at the US Naval Hospital in Okinawa, Japan.

3. Description of Supplies/Services.

The Prism Next system for which the service is required, is an automated chemiluminescent immunoassay system designed to process and detect various diseases in blood samples. The system is designed to enhance blood safety. Service will include four (4) preventative maintenance visits and six (6) emergency maintenance visits in support of the Prism Next System annually. The maintenance service has a required period of performance of 26 September 2015 through 25 September 2016 with four option years. Total contract estimated value if all four option years are exercised is (b)(5) USNH Okinawa has submitted FY15 Defense Health Program Funds in support of the base year of this requirement.

4. Statutory Authority Permitting Other Than Full and Open Competition.

41 U.S.C. 1901 - a sole source acquisition under the authority of the test program for commercial items, as implemented by FAR 13.501(a).

The procurement for annual maintenance services for the Prism Next system must be restricted to Abbott Laboratories. Abbott has the necessary proprietary technical data and replacement parts as well as the approved repair procedures. Abbott is the original equipment manufacturer of the system that is to be maintained through the current requirement and will not release proprietary information to the Government. Currently, Abbott has no authorized dealers capable of performing the services necessary to satisfy the requirement.

6. Description of Efforts Made to Solicit Offers from as Many Offerors as Practicable.

Market Research indicates that the proposed sole source, Abbott Laboratories, is the only known source to provide replacement parts and perform the necessary maintenance to the Prism Next system. The proposed contract will be synopsized and subsequently solicited on the NECO website in order to solicit from as many offerors as possible.

7. Determination of Fair and Reasonable Cost.

The contracting officer has determined the anticipated cost to the Government of the supplies/services covered by this J&A will be fair and reasonable utilizing the appropriate methodology for the contract type.

8. Actions to Remove Barriers to Future Competition.

For the reasons set forth in Paragraph 5, FLC Puget Sound has no plans at this time to compete future contracts for the types of supplies/services covered by this document. If another potential source emerges, FLC Puget Sound will assess whether competition for future requirements is feasible.
