**PLEASE REFER TO THE SECTIONS OF COMBINED SYNOPSIS/SOLICITATION DATED 21 APRIL 2015 AS REQUIRED OR APPROPRIATE.**

The following information is provided in response to RFIs. Numbering is continued from Amendment 0001.

**Q19:** Regarding criterion 7: volume of work. It is required to provide a list of U.S. DoD contracts awarded in the previous five years to include total fees awarded per contract. Firms with multiple offices shall indicate which branch office completed each project. Can you please clarify if this list of U.S. DoD contracts shall be prepared just for the prime contractor or is it requested also for each subcontractor?

**Response 19:** Only the proposed teams Prime Contractor is required to provide a list of U.S. DoD contracts awarded in the previous five years to include total fees awarded per contract for Prime / Sub-Contractor arrangements.

**Q20:** Para IV. Additional submission requirements sub. d) lists: "All projects provided in the SF 330 (Architect-Engineer Qualifications) must be completed by the office/branch/individual team member actually performing the work under this contract. Projects not performed by the office/branch/individual team member will be excluded from evaluation consideration".

Can you please clarify if a prime contractor can include a project performed by a subcontractor who is a member of the proposed team and will perform the work under this contract? This has been the case in the past for similar IDIQ contracts awarded by NAVFAC EURAFSWA, please confirm.

**Response 20:** Answer: The proposed team can include a project performed by a sub-consultant who is a member of the proposed team and will perform the work under this contract. See Criterion 2, (1)a.

**Q21:** regarding criterion 3, capacity of new work. a) For each design team firm, list all current projects being designed by the design team office with a current design fee for construction of greater than \$1,000,000. It is not clear if the \$1,000,000 is related to the design fee of the current projects or to the construction budget of the current projects. Please clarify.

**Response 21:** The \$1,000,000 threshold is for design fee.

**Q22: SUBMISSION REQUIREMENT** for criterion 3 Capacity of new work (page 9)

Calls that:

- For each design team firm, list all current projects being designed by the design team office with a current design fee for construction of greater than \$1,000,000. For each project, identify the current design fee, the current stage (percent completed) of design, and the anticipated design completion date. Indicate the present workload of the firm and the availability of the project team (including subconsultants) for the specified contract performance period; These tables required for subconsultants, not only for prime contractor, shall be very long and will negatively impacting and affecting the quality of the proposal by consuming too much space and not being able to answer properly the remaining RFP requirements. Would you double check and verify if these table can be excluded from the 45 page count? Please confirm.
