The following have been added by full text:

Q&A 1

Question 1: Reference - Attachment J-5 Seed Task Statement of Work. Each Offeror is to estimate each line item in section 4.0 with details regarding labor hours, labor cost, material and total costs. Upon review of Section 4.0 there are numerous references to specific manuals, equipment and spare lists to use as part of the estimating process. It is difficult for an Offeror without the specific technical manual, spares list, or visual images of the equipment to make a reasonable and accurate estimate of the labor hours required to perform specific tasks. Below is a sampling of references extracted from Section 4.0 that are dependent on information that is not available to each Offeror:

- Att J-5, page 2, section 4.1.5.8, *Contractor shall perform general system maintenance to the Heave Compensator in accordance with the FTHE manual.* The FTHE manual or this section of the FHTE manual is not available as part of the solicitation. How may an Offeror be confident that the estimating judgment applied for this line item is compliant or in accordance to the manual?

Answer: Please see the files entitled "FTHE O&M Manual, Draft 06-08-11" (Volumes 1 and 2) attached to this amendment.

- Att J-5, page 2, section 4.1.8.4, *Contractor shall perform general system maintenance to the Winch/Levelwind in accordance with the FTHE manual.* The FTHE manual or this section of the FHTE manual is not available as part of the solicitation. How may an Offeror be confident that the estimating judgment applied for this line item is compliant or in accordance to the manual?

Answer: Please see the files entitled "FTHE O&M Manual, Draft 06-08-11" (Volumes 1 and 2) attached to this amendment.

- Att J-5, page 3, section 4.1.9, *Contractor shall inspect, clean, and test all FTHE system oil ...in accordance with the FTHE manual requirements.* The FTHE manual or this section of the FTHE manual is not available as part of the solicitation. How may an Offeror be confident that the estimating judgment applied for this line item is compliant or in accordance to the manual?

Answer: Please see the files entitled "FTHE O&M Manual, Draft 06-08-11" (Volumes 1 and 2) attached to this amendment.

- Att J-5, page 3, section 4.1.10, *Prior to mobilization, contractor shall inspect and procure new umbilical cursor guides, in accordance with the FTHE manual requirements.* The FTHE manual or this section of the FTHE manual is not available as part of the solicitation. How may an Offeror be confident that the estimating judgment applied for this line item is compliant or in accordance to the manual?

Answer: Please see the files entitled "FTHE O&M Manual, Draft 06-08-11" (Volumes 1 and 2) attached to this amendment.

- Att J-5, page 3, section 4.1.13, *Contractor shall review the existing FTHE Spares list and procure any components needed to keep the FTHE operational.* The FTHE spares list is not part of the PWS or the solicitation. It is difficult for an Offeror to provide an accurate estimate or make a reasonable judgment without the spares list to review.

Answer: Please see the file entitled "FTHEMasterListRFP15.pdf" attached to this amendment.

- Att J-5, page 3, section 4.1.14, *Contractor shall procure equipment rentals, which may include forklifts, and electrical test equipment to support the FTHE related maintenance items.* This requirement is vague. Suggestion is to define this requirement similar to section 4.2.4 in which the Government has provided a specific equipment list and rental items.

Answer: This project routinely rents a ground bond tester after each FTHE mobilization. Also, we plan for the contingency need of a week's rental of small man-lift and week to a month rental of a 10k forklift.

Question 2: Reference – Attachment J-5 Seed Task Statement of Work. The Statement of Work provides project equipment listing for the Offeror to estimate inspection, maintenance, inventories and repairs as the sample task. The statement of work does not provide the age or current condition of this equipment. In order for the Offeror to accurately estimate would the Government consider releasing the age and condition of this equipment and/or furnish visual images?

Answer: The age, condition, and visual images status of the main FTHE components is as follows;

a. Deep Scope Winch - received new by the Government 2010; and are in very good operational and physical condition; pictures available in the operations & maintenance manual.

b. Hydraulic Power Unit - received new by the Government 2010; and are in very good operational and excellent physical condition; pictures available in the operations & maintenance manual.

c. A-Frame - as built drawings dated 2001, and are in very good operational and physical condition, pictures available in the operations & maintenance manual.

d. Heave Compensator - as built drawings dated 2001, and are in very good operational and physical condition, pictures available in the operations & maintenance manual.

e. Power Distribution System - built in 2007, and is in very good operational and physical condition, no picture available at this time in the manual.

f. Control 2 Booth - built in 2010, and is in very good operational and physical condition, no accurate picture is available in the operations and maintenance manual though there is a picture of the previous version.

g. Cable Bridge - built in 2010, and is in excellent physical condition, no picture available at this time in the manual.

3. **DD-254:** Pages 24 and 51 reference a DD-254. Please provide the solicitation DD-254.

Answer: The solicitation draft DD-254 is attached to this amendment.

4. **C.8 OTHER REQUIREMENTS:** In RFP Section C.8, page 13 crew requirements under line items 5,6 and 7 indicate that an Able Bodied Seaman, Ordinary Seaman and Cook shall hold a license under the USCG. These three ratings are not licensed by the USCG; they are unlicensed ratings. Please confirm that the government intended that these positions be credentialed (maintain a valid Merchant Mariners Credential -MMC) in accordance with USCG requirements.

Answer: Yes, these positions must maintain a valid Merchant Mariners Credential (MMC) in accordance with USCG requirements.

5. **DELIVERY INFORMATION:** In RFP Section F, pages 18-19, CLINS 0002-0005 for the option periods currently show the same delivery date as CLIN 0001. Should the Option CLINs read as follows?

0002 POP 01-MAY 2016 TO 30 APR 2017

0003 POP 01-MAY 2017 TO 30 APR 2018

0004 POP 01-MAY 2018 TO 30 APR 2019

0005 POP 01-MAY 2019 TO 30 APR 2020

Answer: Correct, the delivery date information will be updated at the time of award.

6. **Section L.6 Submittal Requirements, Annual Labor Hours by Labor Category, page 54.**

- Please confirm the labor category should be cook throughout the RFP, as show on pages 6, 7, 13, 14 instead of food service manager as listed on page 54.

Answer: Correct, the labor category should be cook throughout the RFP instead of food service manager as listed on page 54.

- The Mate position reflects a separate entry for overtime. Please confirm that the Mate position is not an overtime eligible position.

Answer: Correct, the Mate position is not an overtime eligible position.

7. **Page 53-54, 2(a) Schedule of Estimated Costs:**

- The solicitation refers to one base period and two option periods. Please confirm that this should be four option periods to be consistent with page 18, which indicates a base period of one year and four option periods.

Answer: Correct, this procurement is for a base period of one year and four option year periods.

- The solicitation indicates Option Period 3 has a six month period of performance. Please confirm that this should be a 12 month period of performance.

Answer: Correct, Option Period 3 should be a 12 month period of performance.

8. The RFP labor categories map to WD 94-0196; however, the RFP references WD 05-2071 for pricing the SCA categories on page 54. Please confirm that the offeror should use WD 94-0196.

Answer: Offerors should use WD-94-0196 in lieu of 05-2071.

9. DELIVERABLE DATA: In RFP Attachment J-5, Section 5.0 Deliverable Data, Task item numbers 5.2 and 5.3 are missing. Please confirm that this is a typographical error and that the CDRL numbers as listed from A001 to A006 in RFP Attachment J-6 will take precedence?

Answer: Yes, the missing task item numbers 5.2 and 5.3 are a typographical error. The CDRL numbers as listed from A001 to A006 will take precedence.

10. CDRL A005: In RFP Attachment J-6, Page 4 of 6 of the Contract Data Requirements List, Data Item No. 1 reads A005. Will the Government please confirm that should be A004?

Answer: It should be A004.
