1. Question #1: I noticed in FedBizOps you posted the solicitation. I tried to open and download from several computers it didn't work. Will this be reposted?

Response to Question #1: The Solicitation and all the attachments were posted and downloadable when Amendments 1 and 2 were posted in Navy Electronic Commerce Online (NECO) and Federal Business Opportunities (FEDBIZOPS) on 29 Jan 2015. There are a total of nine (9) documents: Solicitation and 8 Attachments. This will not be reposted.

Follow the steps below to view and download the solicitation and the 8 attachments:

- a. If you are in FedBizOps click on Amendment 2 link

2. Question #2: We have the solicitation now, but some of the attachments are still missing.

Response to Question #2: See Response to Question #1 above.

3. Question #3: We would like to confirm the size standard for your requirement for Lifecycle Sustainment and Integrated Product Support (IPS) Services under solicitation number N39430-15-R-1603. The size-standard mentioned in RFP is \$15M. As per the SBA Size Standard Table (below), would you please change the size standard from \$15M to \$38.5M to increase the level of competition amongst small businesses?

541330 Engineering Services \$15.0 Million.

Except, Military and Aerospace Equipment and Military Weapons \$38.5 Million.

Except, Contracts and Subcontracts for Engineering Services Awarded Under the National Energy Policy Act of 1992 \$38.5 Except, Marine Engineering and Naval Architecture \$38.5 Million.

Response to Question #3: Small Business Size Standard is changed:

FROM Size Standard NAICS 541330 Engineering Services, \$15 Million changed

TO new Size Standard NAICS 541330 Engineering Services Military and Aerospace Equipment and Military Weapons, \$38.5 Million.

The change is also now reflected in Section K, FAR Clause 52.219-1 (Incorporated as full text) of this solicitation.

4. Question #4: Understanding that Solicitation Number N39430-15-R-1603 references NAICS code

541330 with size standard \$15M, would the government be open to changing the size standard for the subject solicitation to \$35.5M?

Response to Question #4: See Response to Question #3 above.

5. Question #5: Is RFP N39430-15-R-1603 a full & open or set-aside solicitation? It was not apparent to this reader.

Response to Question #5: This is a Total Small Business Set-Aside. The Government Point of Entry (GPE), Federal Business Opportunities (FBO) reflects it on the General Information and reads as follows: "Set Aside: Total Small Business". The solicitation has a clause FAR Part 52.219-6 -- Notice of Total Small Business Set-Aside incorporated as a reference in Section I.

6. Question #6: Just want to let you know that the Solicitation N3943015R1603 is referring to several attachments that still to be posted for public. Some of them are pretty essential to connect the governments intent. We are in a full blown proposal writing stage, those attachment will make a difference which way we are headed. Please advise.

Response to Question #6: See Response to Question #1 above.

7. Question #7: Section J-List of Documents, Exhibits and other Attachments. Of the 8 Attachments listed only the first three are included in the solicitation. Where can I get Attachments 4-7?

Response to Question #7: See Response to Question #1 above.

8. Question #8: Is there an incumbent for this work?

Response to Question #8: Yes there are incumbents for this work. The previous requirement was awarded as an Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) Multiple Award Contract (MAC) to the following three companies/contracts: Computer Science Corporation (CSC)/N62583-09-D-0061; AT&T Government Solutions (AT&T)/N62583-09-D-0062; and Synectic Solutions, Inc. (SSI)/N62583-09-D-0063.

9. Question #9: Attachments 7 and 8 are mentioned several places in the solicitation. Could you please provide Attachments 7 - Schedule of Total Estimated Price and Attachment 8 - Past Performance Questionnaire?

Response to Question #9: See Response to Question #1 above.

10. Question #10: We have reviewed the documents posted for the subject Solicitation, and want to confirm the size standard for this opportunity. The announcement from GovWin indicates that the size standard is \$15M except \$38.5M for Military and Aerospace Equipment and Military Weapons and Contracts and Subcontracts for Engineering Services Awarded under the National Energy Policy of 1992. The actual Solicitation document on page 68/88 indicates however that the size standard is \$15M. Please confirm that the size standard for this Solicitation includes the \$38.5M exception due to the nature of the work.

Response to Question #10: See Response to Question #3 above.

(a)(1) The North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) code for this acquisition is 541330.

(2) The small business size standard is US\$38.5M.

(3) The small business size standard for a concern which submits an offer in its own name, other than on a construction or service contract, but which proposes to furnish a product which it did not itself manufacture, is 500 employees.

(b) Representations.

(1) The offeror represents as part of its offer that it ( ) is, ( ) is not a small business concern.

(2) (Complete only if the offeror represented itself as a small business concern in paragraph (b)(1) of this provision.) The offeror represents, for general statistical purposes, that it ( ) is, ( ) is not a small disadvantaged business concern as defined in 13 CFR 124.1002.

(c) Definitions. As used in this provision--

“Economically disadvantaged women-owned small business (EDWOSB) concern” means a small business concern that is at least 51 percent directly and unconditionally owned by, and the management and daily business operations of which are controlled by, one or more women who are citizens of the United States and who are economically disadvantaged in accordance with 13 CFR part 127. It automatically qualifies as a women-owned small business concern eligible under the WOSB Program.

Service-disabled veteran-owned small business concern--

(1) Means a small business concern--

(i) Not less than 51 percent of which is owned by one or more service-disabled veterans or, in the case of any publicly owned business, not less than 51 percent of the stock of which is owned by one or more service-disabled veterans; and

(ii) The management and daily business operations of which are controlled by one or more service-disabled veterans or, in the case of a service-disabled veteran with permanent and severe disability, the spouse or permanent caregiver of such veteran.

(2) Service-disabled veteran means a veteran, as defined in 38 U.S.C. 101(2), with a disability that is service-connected, as defined in 38 U.S.C. 101(16).

"Small business concern," means a concern, including its affiliates, that is independently owned and operated, not dominant in the field of operation in which it is bidding on Government contracts, and qualified as a small business under the criteria in 13 CFR Part 121 and the size standard in paragraph (a) of this provision.

Veteran-owned small business concern means a small business concern--

(1) Not less than 51 percent of which is owned by one or more veterans (as defined at 38 U.S.C. 101(2)) or, in the case of any publicly owned business, not less than 51 percent of the stock of which is owned by one or more veterans; and

(2) The management and daily business operations of which are controlled by one or more veterans.

"Women-owned small business concern," means a small business concern --

(1) That is at least 51 percent owned by one or more women; in the case of any publicly owned business, at least 51 percent of the stock of which is owned by one or more women; and

(2) Whose management and daily business operations are controlled by one or more women.

"Women-owned small business (WOSB) concern eligible under the WOSB Program (in accordance with 13 CFR part 127)", means a small business concern that is at least 51 percent directly and unconditionally owned by, and the management and daily business operations of which are controlled by, one or more women who are citizens of the United States.

(d) Notice.

(1) If this solicitation is for supplies and has been set aside, in whole or in part, for small business concerns, then the clause in this solicitation providing notice of the set-aside contains restrictions on the source of the end items to be furnished.

(2) Under 15 U.S.C. 645(d), any person who misrepresents a firm's status as a business concern that is small, HUBZone small, small disadvantaged, service-disabled veteran-owned small, economically disadvantaged women-owned small, or women-owned small eligible under the WOSB Program in order to obtain a contract to be awarded under the preference programs established pursuant to section 8, 9, 15, 31, and 36 of the Small Business Act or any other provision of Federal law that specifically references section 8(d) for a definition of program eligibility, shall—

(i) Be punished by imposition of fine, imprisonment, or both;

(ii) Be subject to administrative remedies, including suspension and debarment; and

(iii) Be ineligible for participation in programs conducted under the authority of the Act.
