The Private Boat Storage Area is used for storage and maintenance of private civilian boats. The total site area is approximately 4 acres and consists mostly of pervious gravel and grass.

The DLA Scrap Yard is used for storage of equipment and materials awaiting disposal or recycle. NSGL vehicles, pallets, wood debris, metal scrap, and an assortment of other debris.


