RFI'S

Q1. Can the work be accomplished with 2 mobilizations? For example, given that there is extensive equipment and materials located within the warehouse, can all this be moved to one side of the warehouse, complete the required epoxy floor and then after relocated all materials and equipment to the finished side, complete the remainder of the project?

A1. The Government will break this work out into 3 sections, with the final area being cleared and used for staging the materials from the other sections being done 1 at a time. There is limited space and a lot of material. See attached Staging Area Drawing.

Q2. Please verify if there is an existing coating to be removed?

A2. There is no existing coating, just some lines that were painted on the floor.

Q3. Are we to remove the existing ie. Grinding or just prep it for paint?

A3. See answer to question 2

Q4. How much concrete repair work is required?

A4. Providing a concrete assessment report is a requirement of the job. If it is determined that repairs are required to the concrete before applying the flooring paint, the contractor shall submit a quote to the Government for the necessary repairs.

Q5. How many linear feet of control joint sand expansion joints (flexible sealant material) is required to be replaces?

A5. The contractor shall provide flexible sealant material for a warehouse that is approximately 220' x 125'. The contractor shall verify dimensions on site.

Q6. Is it going to be a solid color, ie. gray?

A6. Yes, a solid color gray. With lines provided. The Government will provide a drawing for the lines (see attached). Further clarification will be provided in additional amendment.

Q7. Do we have to move all equipment in the building or are government employees going to?

A7. See answer to question 1. The Government will clear out one section of all materials. The Contractor shall then be responsible to move shelves and material from one area into this area. See Attached Drawing.

Q8. Is the entire floor in the square footage to be coated?

A8. Yes. The SF shall not include the office spaces and restrooms. Section 2.2 states that the Contractor shall verify all dimensions

Q9. What is presently on the concrete substrate receiving the coating?

A9. There is no existing coating just some lines that were painted on the floor.

Q10. What method of removal is being spec'd?

A10. None. Manufacture's recommendation.

Q11. Is there a specific product that you would like applied to the floor? Sherwin Williams, Benjamin Moore?

A11. The Government will not specify a particular product or brand, but does specify in Section 1.11.3 that the Contractor shall submit cut sheets for all materials to be used under this Contract.

Q12. How many linear feet of joint sealant is going to need to be installed? Which sealant do you want installed? Sherwin Williams, Sika, BASF? Will the current joint sealant need to be removed?

A12. See answer to question 5. Further clarification will be provided in additional amendment.

Q13. Is there any kind of allowance for concrete patching?

A13. See answer to question 4

Q14. Will there be a second site visit to do a comprehensive review of the RFI's presented by contractors?

A14. At this time the Government will not be holding a second site visit. Additional pictures of the site have been attached via this amendment.

Q15. Is there an existing coating on the concrete floor

A15. There is no existing coating just some lines that were painted on the floor.

Q16. Will the contractor be required to perform patch repairs to failed concrete.

A16. See answer to question 4

Q17. Are there MBE goals for this contract.


A17. NO. This solicitation is a small business set-aside.


Q1. What are the Navy's acceptable coating manufactures for the new coating (PPG, tademic, American safety tech, etc)
