1	Would the Government consider extending the completion for Relevant Projects to 7 years? We have noticed 7 years as being the normal requirement on several recent NAVFAC procurements. The downturn in the economy coupled with the Government's recent construction budget challenges has resulted in fewer completed projects within a 5 year period.	No, the completion period is unchanged at 5 years.
2	The RFP states to submit the following with the proposal submission: "SF1442, signed with all amendments acknowledged; Price Proposal Form; Copy of Representation and Certifications from ORCA; Bid Bond; Vets-100; Include a cover page with Solicitation Number, Solicitation Title, Prime Contractor Name, Address, Phone Number, Fax Number, DUNS, Cage Code, Point of Contact, phone number, and email address." Please confirm the Price Proposal and Bid Bond do not have to be submitted with the Phase 1 proposal as these are typically submitted in Phase 2.	Price Proposal shall not be submitted with the Phase 1 proposal per Section 10 of Page 1.
3	Since an ACASS is not available for government design-build contracts, please confirm if it is acceptable for a design-build prime contractor (as the Offeror) to submit the design-build prime contractor's CCASS evaluation as evidence of past performance of the design partner, if the design partner of the featured project is the same as the proposed design partner.	Yes, it is acceptable.

4	In a government design-build project where the prime construction contractor holds the design-build contract, government clients are frequently unwilling to fill out PPQs for the contractor's AE design-partner, since there is no direct contractual relationship between that government client and the AE firm. Please clarify if a PPQ, filled out by the design-build contractor, is an acceptable evaluation for the AE partner's design past performance, since the contractor is a client of that AE firm.	The contractor is not considered a client of that AE firm for these purposes and should not submit a PPQ as such. Per Page 12: "If the Offeror is unable to obtain a completed PPQ from a client for a project(s) before proposal closing date, the Offeror shall complete and submit with the proposal the first page of the PPQ, which will provide contract and client information for the respective project(s)."
5	If an existing CCASS discusses both design and construction within the CCASS evaluation, will it be acceptable for the CCASS to be used for a project that is used for both design and construction experience within Factor 2?	See response to Inquiry #3.
6	Will it be acceptable if the Offeror uses a recent existing PPQ if the PPQ obtains similar information as the PPQ-0 form provided in the RFP? Also, will it be acceptable if the Offeror uses a recent existing PPQ if it is an existing PPQ-0 form provided in a previous RFP?	Yes, both scenarios are acceptable.
7	The RFP states "The offeror shall submit (1) original, marked "Original", and (1) copy, marked "copy", in a separate three ring binder (1&1/2 inch. minimum)" for the Price Proposal. Will the Government please provide how many copies are to be submitted with the Phase 1 Technical proposal?	See response to Inquiry #2.
8	Factor 2 - Experience, Part (a), Subparagraph (2) - Design Experience, indicates that the design portion of the project experience shall have been completed within the past 5 years. Is it acceptable to use projects with construction completion within the past 5 years in lieu of design completion within the past 5 years? We have seen the construction complete date utilized in recent RFPs.	No, the design must be completed within 5 years per Page 11.
