THIS SOLICITATION IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

1. THE FOLLOWING PORTIONS OF THE Request For Proposal (RFP) N40085-15-R-7613 SHOWN IN SECTION 00100 Bidding Schedule/Instructions to Bidders, BASIS OF AWARD, ARE HEREBY AMENDED AS SHOWN BELOW. THE STRIKETHROUGH TEXT IS REMOVED AND REPLACED WITH THE TEXT WHICH FOLLOWS THE STRIKETHROUGH.

- a. Amend Section D. PAST PERFORMANCE EVALUATION

2. There are two aspects to the past performance evaluation. The first is to evaluate the offeror's past performance to determine how relevant a recent effort accomplished by the offeror is to the effort to be acquired through the source selection. ~~Relevant performance defined as storm drainage work to include removal and replacement of similar diameter and length with similar complexity, contract type, and degree of subcontract/teaming effort.~~ Relevant performance defined as installation of insulated metal panels on a building exterior.

- b. Amend Section E. EVALUATION FACTORS FOR AWARD

- (2) FACTOR 2 – EXPERIENCE:

- (a) Solicitation Submittal Requirements:

The Offeror shall submit the following information:

- (1) Construction Experience:

Submit a maximum of five (5) and a minimum of two (2) relevant construction projects for the Offeror that best demonstrates your experience on relevant projects that are similar in size, scope, and complexity to the RFP. For purposes of this evaluation, a relevant project is further defined as installation of insulated metal panels on a building exterior.

Projects submitted for the Offeror shall be completed within the past five (5) years of the date of issuance of this RFP. A project is defined as a construction project performed under a single task order or contract. For multiple award and indefinite delivery/indefinite quantity type contracts, the contract as a whole shall not be submitted as a project; rather Offerors shall submit the work performed under a task order as a project.

The attached Construction & Design Experience Project Data Sheet (Attachment D) is MANDATORY and SHALL be used to submit project information. If the same project is being used to demonstrate construction and design experience, submit separate Project Data Sheets for construction and design. Except as specifically requested, the Government will not consider information submitted in addition

to this form. Individual blocks on this form may be expanded; however, total length for each project data sheet shall not exceed one (1) double-sided page (or two (2) single-sided pages).

For all submitted projects, the description of the project shall clearly describe the scope of work performed and the relevancy to the project requirements of this RFP (i.e.: unique features, area, construction methods).

If the Offeror is a Joint Venture (JV), relevant project experience should be submitted for projects completed by the Joint Venture entity. If the Joint Venture does not have shared experience, projects may be submitted for the Joint Venture members. Offerors who fail to submit experience for all Joint Venture members may be rated lower. Offerors are still limited to a total of five (5) projects combined.

If an Offeror is utilizing experience information of affiliates/subsidiaries/parent/LLC/LTD member companies (name is not exactly as stated on the SF1442), the proposal shall clearly demonstrate that the affiliate/subsidiary/parent firm will have meaningful involvement in the performance of the contract.

Note: ~~Experience of Subcontractors will not be considered.~~ If the Offeror does not have relevant experience, the Offeror may submit relevant experience from a subcontractor that will perform major or critical aspects of the requirement to demonstrate construction experience under this evaluation factor. The Offer must provide a letter of commitment and an explanation of the meaningful involvement that the subcontractor will have in performance of this contract. More weight may be given to the Offeror's projects than to those submitted for subcontractors.

8. In regards to Factor 2 Experience. Item 1 it states "for purposes of this evaluation, a relevant project is further defined as installation of insulated metal panels on a building exterior" It further states Experienced of Subcontractors will not be consider.  
In reviewing the scope of work although you do have metal panels on the exterior of the building many other elements are being completed as well. Removal of Transit, both new personal doors and new overhead panel doors, Electrical and lighting work, Concrete apron work, mechanical work and brick work are just a few. This project seems like it should be managed more by a general contractor who has the experience to manage multiple trades and the overall general contractors experience should be taken into account verses just siding work. Most general contractors would sub out the siding work on a project but complete a lot of this other work mentioned above however a siding contractor would probably have no experience at some of these other items mentioned above. Since you are not consider using sub-contractor experience to meet this requirement could you change what the relevant experience of the project is in regards to evaluation that will take into account some of these other items mentioned above? I believe from a bidding perspective you would have better participation and it would also be a fairer representation of this project.

RESPONSE – The relevant experience text has been changed for the required submittal for Factor 2-- Experience, for Construction Experience ONLY as shown above. The NOTE: “Experience of Subcontractors will not be considered.” is hereby removed as shown in the Strikethrough text above and replaced with the NOTE: text which follows the strikethrough. Experience of Subcontractors will be considered for this factor. The Offer must provide a letter of commitment and an explanation of the meaningful involvement that the subcontractor will have in performance of this contract.
