SITE VISIT INSTRUCTIONS

SITE VISIT

1. Date & Time – **Site visit will take place on Tuesday April 28, 2015 beginning at 0800 HRS CST.** Visitor requests must be received no later than **April 21, 2015**, anyone accessing Great Lakes Naval Station must be a US citizen and submit a visit request in advance of the visit. Requests submitted on the day of the visit will be denied.

2. Location - The site visit will begin at 0800 HRS CST with an in briefing in the 1st floor main conference room at:

Building 2016 is not located within the Great Lakes Naval Station fence line. Following the in briefing all participants will board a bus to embark on the site visit. Participants should plan on a full day for the site visit. An agenda for the visit will be forthcoming.

3. Pre Site Visit requirements:

a. **All visitors must be U.S. Citizens.** If you are a Naturalized Citizen you must present either a valid US passport or your original naturalization papers and a valid government-issued photo ID (example: driver's license) upon checking in on the day of the site visit. **No exceptions.**

b. **All visitors must present valid proof of citizenship to enter Great Lakes Naval Station.** ID will be required to be presented at all secured gate and entrance locations throughout the site visit. Valid proof of citizenship must consist of one of the following:

- Valid US Passport
- Valid photo ID (example: Driver's License)

c. All Visitor Requests must provide the following information:

- Company Name, Individual's Name, Date of Birth and Social Security Number (may be phoned in)

- The visit request is mandatory for all visitors who do not currently have a NCACS (RapidGate) badge **that is approved for Great Lakes Naval Station, Great Lakes, Illinois** regardless of the duration or classification of the visit. Access to Great Lakes Naval Station will not be granted to any individual under any circumstance without a valid visit request on file.
- All personnel are subject to search.
