1. Can base police services be hired for traffic control for the project? If so, what is the hourly rate?

Base police services are not for hire.

2. Will detours be allowed to be setup?

3. How many areas can we mill at one time?

The contractor is not constrained to any set number of areas, however, advance coordination is key.

4. How many days can we leave a surface milled?

No time limit; however, if left unpaved for five days or greater, sweep cleaning and a tack coat must be applied prior to paving.

5. Is the crack filling specified for after the pavement is milled? (This is in reference to cracks found in the base asphalt after milling. Per design expectations, are these cracks to be filled prior to laydown of asphalt?)

Cracks are to be filled after milling and prior to pavement overlay.
