Sign and seal fabrication drawings by a Professional Engineer registered in the State where the project is located. Include complete information for the fabrication and erection of the structure's components, including the location, type, and size of bolts, welds, member sizes and lengths, connection details, blocks, copes, and cuts. Double connections that require an erection seat to comply with OSHA 29 CFR 1926.756(c) (1) shall be shown on the shop drawings, reviewed and approved by the structural engineer of record." All other references to the professional engineer do not indicate the state where the project is located. As we read this, the PE would have to be registered in the State of Maine, is this correct? It then states, "Sign and seal fabrication drawings by a Professional Engineer registered in the State where the project is located." Specification Section 085e addresses Design Development Drawings should be stamped by a PE, but does not call for all detailed shop drawings to be PE stamped. G-004		On Plan Sheet G-004, Concrete Notes, note 19 states, "Anticipate water infiltration during construction. Prior to placing concrete, inject cracks with chemical grout to arrest water flow. Placements will not be permitted with water actively weeping or flowing." Prior to the bid we are unable to quantify the quantity of cracks that will need this injection. Please consider providing a unit price with an assumed quantity for this work.	Contractor shall assume 250 LF of crack injection for bidding purposes. 13 & 18 of 48		In the contract solicitation on page 13 of 48 it states, "Projects submitted for the Offeror shall be completed within the past ten (10) years of the date of issuance of this RFP." It then states on page 18 of 48, "If there is not a completed CCASS or CPARS evaluation then the offeror must submit Past Performance Questionnaires (Attachment B) for each project included in Factor 1 for Construction Experience. The Offeror should provide completed Past Performance Questionnaires (PPQ) with the proposal." If the offeror includes a project that is currently under construction, but contains components that have been completed that correlate to the Factor 1 experience, should the offeror submit a PPQ from the owner?
