The following have been added by full text:

Responses to Contractor Requests for Information (RFI's)

1. RFI Reference – pg. 48 Factor 2 (1) Construction Experience: “The Corporate Approach narrative shall be limited to one (1) double-sided page (or two (2) single-sided pages) including the organizational chart.” RFI: Can the organizational chart be included on a 3rd single-sided page to allow a full two (2) single-sided page narrative describing the approach? Due to the space a typical organizational chart consumes on a page we feel this will allow additional room for approach text.

RESPONSE: Please adhere to the established page limitations for this factor.

2. The SF 1442 states to provide an original and 5 copies of our response while Section 00800 states an original and 6 copies. What is the correct number of copies?

RESPONSE: Please provide original and six (6) hard copies for technical proposals. Provide original and one (1) hard copy of the price proposal. A CD is also required.

"In the event of any inconsistency between the original, CD, or hard copies for any of the above, the original will govern."

3. In other recent Navy solicitations we have responded to, we have seen either no minimum font requirements, or minimum font sizes below 12 point. The Factor 2 Construction & Design Experience Project Data Sheets (Attachment D) require us to provide detailed descriptions of our projects. We respectfully request that the minimum font size requirement for this Phase 1 proposal response to be reduced to 10 point, to allow for more detailed content.

RESPONSE: The Government will allow ten point font for this solicitation.

4. Regarding the Factor 2 relevancy requirements for Simulator Training Facilities, the RFP cites size, scope, and complexity criteria that, taken together, do not reflect the historical market for these kinds of facilities. In our experience with these types of simulator facilities, we have not seen requirements that combine such large SF, higher project value, and high-bay requirements in one simulator project. In order for the Government to receive a responsible number of competitive offers, we respectfully request that the complexity criteria for 25' high-bay

experience, if it is a critical feature of the proposed project, be separated from the Simulator Training Facility category and placed in a separate, third experience category of its own.

RESPONSE: The Factor 2 relevancy requirements will remain unchanged.

5. In a government design-build project where the prime construction contractor holds the design-build contract, government clients are frequently not in a position to fill out PPQs for the contractor's AE design-partner, since there is no direct contractual relationship between that government client and the AE firm. And, of course, there is no ACASS provided to the design partner, for the same reason. Please clarify if a PPQ, filled out by the design-build contractor, is an acceptable evaluation for the AE partner's design past performance, since the contractor is a client of that AE firm.

RESPONSE: The PPQ states, *NOTE: NAVFAC REQUESTS THAT THE CLIENT COMPLETES THIS QUESTIONNAIRE AND SUBMITS DIRECTLY BACK TO THE OFFEROR. THE OFFEROR WILL SUBMIT THE COMPLETED QUESTIONNAIRE TO NAVFAC WITH THEIR PROPOSAL, AND MAY DUPLICATE THIS QUESTIONNAIRE FOR FUTURE SUBMISSION ON NAVFAC SOLICITATIONS. CLIENTS ARE HIGHLY ENCOURAGED TO SUBMIT QUESTIONNAIRES DIRECTLY TO THE OFFEROR. HOWEVER, QUESTIONNAIRES MAY BE SUBMITTED DIRECTLY TO NAVFAC. PLEASE CONTACT THE OFFEROR FOR NAVFAC POC INFORMATION. THE GOVERNMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO VERIFY ANY AND ALL INFORMATION ON THIS FORM.* The Government will accept Past Performance Questionnaire's filled out by Design-Build contractors to demonstrated past performance for the design partner.

6. Reference Page 59 out of 86, G. Submission Requirements. The RFP notes that Phase 1 is "Limited to 15 pages, including the 3 conceptual drawings – page count excludes cover page and tabs", yet there are no conceptual drawings that need to be provided with Phase 1. Please confirm the page limitations are as follows: Factor 1, Corporate Approach - One (1) double-sided page (or two (2) single-sided pages) including the organizational chart; Factor 2, Experience - Total length for each project data sheet shall not exceed one (1) double-sided page (or two (2) single-sided pages); Factor 3, Past Performance – No page limitation for evaluation forms and Performance Recognition documents; and, Factor 4, Safety - The Technical Approach for Safety shall be limited to one (1) double-sided page or two (2) single-sided pages.

RESPONSE: Please adhere to the page limitations in the Request for Proposal. The sentence referred to in this RFI included the language "3 conceptual drawings" by mistake. Section should read, "Limited to 15 pages, page count excludes cover page and tabs. PAGES THAT EXCEED THE PAGE LIMITATION SHALL NOT BE EVALUATED."

7. Will the Government please consider providing a two week extension to the current due date for this solicitation? This extension would help to ensure that our team is able solidify teaming arrangements and obtain PPQ's requested during the Holiday season. This extension would also enhance our team's ability to provide an accurate RFP response and service this project to the standards required.

RESPONSE: Unfortunately, the schedule does not allow any Phase I proposal due date extensions at this time.

8. On page 59 of 60, item G. Submittal Requirements, (1) Technical Requirements for Phase I, the RFP states that proposals are “limited to 15 pages, including the 3 conceptual drawings”. Normally, conceptual drawings are not required in a Phase I proposal. This same specification is also in the Technical Requirements for Phase II.

Please confirm that conceptual drawings are not required for the Phase I proposal. Please also confirm that the 15-page limit only includes the cover page, Factor 1 Corporate Approach narrative, Factor 2 Attachment D forms, and the Factor 4 Safety Narrative, and does not include PPQs, CCASS, ACASS, performance recognition documents, table of contents, tabs, slip sheets, cover letter, or SF 1442.

RESPONSE: Confirmed, 15-page limit only includes the cover page, Factor 1 Corporate Approach narrative, Factor 2 Attachment D forms, and the Factor 4 Safety Narrative, and does not include PPQs, CCASS, ACASS, performance recognition documents, table of contents, tabs, slip sheets, cover letter, or SF 1442.

Also, conceptual drawings are not required for the Phase I proposal.

9. Can previously completed PPQs formatted the same or similar to Attachment C (Form PPQ-0) be submitted within in the proposal submission in place of requesting a new PPQ for this solicitation?

RESPONSE: Yes

10. The SF 1442 states 745 days for completion, but p.4 and p. 22 of the RFQ states 730 days. The NTP to construction is listed as 15 days on p. 22 of the RFP, but 10 days on the 1442. Clarification of the NTP to construction and overall project duration would be greatly appreciated.

RESPONSE: The Notice To Proceed on the SF1442 should read 15 days instead of 10 days. Work will be completed within 745 days of award and 730 days of notice to proceed.
