**JUSTIFICATION AND APPROVAL
FOR USE OF OTHER THAN FULL AND OPEN COMPETITION**

1. Contracting Activity. Naval Facilities Engineering Command, (NAVFAC) Mid-Atlantic, Hampton Roads IPT.
2. Description of the Action Being Approved. This procurement will result in a firm-fixed-price construction contract. The contract will be solicited full and open and contractor will be selected via best value selection. This justification provides for the use of a restrictive source to limit competition for the use of MGC Roofing & Construction to maintain roofing warranty.
3. Description of Supplies/Services. The Contractor shall furnish all labor, supervision, management, materials, supplies, equipment, tools, transportation and incidental engineering required to perform all work associated with roof penetration removal, repair and replacement for Hangar 111 at Naval Air Station Oceana in Virginia Beach, Va. The estimated value of this action is [redacted information] and will be funded by FY16 Operations & Maintenance, Navy (O&M,N) funds. The period of performance is from 15 September 2016 through 12 April 2019.
4. Statutory Authority Permitting Other Than Full and Open Competition. Pursuant to FAR 6.302-1, this acquisition will be acquired under the authority of 10 U.S.C. 2304(c)(1), *Only One Responsible Source and No Other Supplies or Services Will Satisfy Agency Requirements.*
5. Rationale Justifying Use of Cited Statutory Authority. An IDIQ roofing contract to replace the roofing of Hangar 111 was completed in July 2015 and included a 20 year warranty with John Manville from the approved roofing contractor, MGC Roofing & Construction. The A&E service contract to fully design Project RM13-1762, Fire Protection and Structural Repairs to Hangar 111, was awarded after the completion of the roofing replacement contract. The RM13-1762 project requires inspection and evaluation of structural members penetrating the roof sections. To perform such tasks, the removal of existing roofing to allow structural inspections under the contract and roof replacement is required. According to the warranty and the John Manville representative, the approved roofing contractor must perform the work to preserve and maintain the roof warranty.
6. Description of Efforts Made to Solicit Offers from as Many Offerors as Practicable. This does not apply since the reason for other than full and open competition is to preserve and maintain the roof warranty.


