1. Replace drawings GI002, SD102, SD103, S-109 and S-110 with attached drawings GI002, SD102, SD103, S-109 and S-110.
2. For Option 1 on sheet SD103 delete demolition of building CAD 209 from bent 244 to bent 248 and delete demolition of the concrete deck for the batter piles. On drawing plan S-110 delete installation of 4 batter piles at bent 247.
3. Add Option 2 to contract to demolish CMU building CAD 209 and install 4 batter piles, Giant Voice equipment on building 209 will be re-located by others. Demolish all electrical equipment from building 209 including but not limited to the secondary unit substation, dry-type transformer, HVAC and associated equipment, panel boards, lighting fixtures, electrical outlets, hot water tank, and conduit and wiring. Demolish existing medium voltage power circuit (conduit and wiring) that provides primary power to the secondary unit substation located in building 209.
4. Specification 01 35 40.00 25, Paragraph 3.5.1.1 - Delete "and shall not be located on the pier." from the third sentence.
5. Specification 01 11 00, Paragraph 3.1 - Delete second subparagraph (b).
6. Specification 01 45 02, Paragraph 1.5.5 - Delete "and who may perform production related duties but must be allowed sufficient time to perform their assigned quality control duties" from the first sentence.
7. Add Option 2 to contract to demolish building and install 4 batter piles, Giant Voice equipment on building 209 will be re-located by others. Demolish all electrical equipment from building 209 including but not limited to the secondary unit substation, dry-type transformer, panel boards, lighting fixtures, electrical outlets, HVAC equipment, conduit and wiring. Demolish existing medium voltage power circuit (conduit and wiring) that provides primary power to the secondary unit substation located in building 209.
8. Outages will be coordinated with the contracting officer and with ship schedules and the Fire Department, and should be kept to a minimum.
