CLIN 0001 – BASE BID: Price for the all the work for B448, B465, B499, B520, B533 and B592 including fall protection for these building in accordance with the drawings and specifications, but excluding work described in CLIN 0002 and CLIN 0003.

CLIN 0002 – OPTION ITEM NUMBER 1: Price for providing all work for B518 including fall protection, complete in accordance with the drawings and specifications, but excluding work described in CLIN 0001, and CLIN 0003.

CLIN 0003 – OPTION ITEM NUMBER 2: Price for providing all work for B519 including fall protection, complete in accordance with the drawings and specifications, but excluding work described in CLIN 0001 and CLIN 0002.

TOTAL PRICE FOR ALL CLINs (0001-0003) \$ _____

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NOTES:

1. Award will be made on the total sum of all CLINs 0001 through 0003.
2. The Government reserves the unilateral right to award CLINs 0002 and 0003 to the contractor at the proposed price within 365 calendar days after contract award. A firm fixed proposed price is required for CLINs 0001 through 0003. No provision is made for economic price adjustment. If Options are exercised, the contract completion date remains 380 calendar days after award of the contract.
3. If CLINs 0002 and 0003 are exercised, additional bonding and consent of surety will be required. Consequently, the Performance Bond shall reflect 100 percent of the aggregate amount of all CLINs.
4. Failure to enter a price for any of the CLINs will result in the proposal being rejected as unacceptable. The Government may reject an offer as nonresponsive if it is materially unbalanced as to prices for the basic requirement and the option quantities. An offer is unbalanced when it is based on prices significantly less than cost for some work and prices which are significantly overstated for other work.
5. Evaluation of Options (JUL 1990): Except when it is determined in accordance with FAR 17.206 (b) not to be in the Government's best interest, the Government will evaluate offers for award purposes by adding the price for the Option(s) to the total price for CLIN 0001. In accordance with FAR 52.217-5, evaluation of options will not obligate the Government to exercise the Option(s).
