The procedures of FAR 13.5 will be used in this particular acquisition. This announcement constitutes the only solicitation; quotes are requested and a written solicitation will not be issued.
- II. Solicitation number N40192-15-Q-7052 is issued as a Request for Quotation (RFQ).
