This is a combined synopsis/solicitation for commercial items prepared in accordance with the format in Federal Acquisition Regulations (FAR) subpart 12.6, as supplemented with additional information included in this notice. The procedures of FAR 13.5 will be used in this particular acquisition. This announcement constitutes the only solicitation; proposals are requested and a written solicitation will not be issued.
- II. Solicitation number N40192-15-Q-7080 is issued as a request for quotation (RFQ).
- III. The solicitation document and incorporated provisions and clauses are those in effect through Federal Acquisition Circular 2005-84.
- IV. This solicitation has been set aside for small business concerns under the 314999 NAICS Code, with a size standard of 500 employees.
