1	10/30/16	The GPR model specified was replaced in April of this year by new model the 2550GR (see attached press release and product info). While the models are very similar in performance characteristics, the 2550GR supports a more current version of Microsoft Windows (Windows 7, etc). The 2450GR only supports Windows versions that are no longer available or supported (Windows 2000, Windows XP Professional). Can the specification for GPR be changed to require bidding of the current model rather than the outdated version.	The specifications have been revised to require model number 2550GR or equal (see Enclosure (2) to revised specifications).
2	10/30/16	We recommend that specific requirements for the tablet computer to be used with the GPR also be included with the solicitation. The way the PC Tablet is currently stated in the solicitation will allow bidders to recommend a very low cost PC tablet that meets the bare	The specifications have been revised to require tablet or laptop model number Panasonic Tough Book CF-20 or equal (See Enclosure (1) to revised specifications).

		minimum specifications but will not operate well for the GPR application. Based on our experience of operating a GPR for 3 years, the PC tablet used with the GPR really determines the effectiveness of the GPR unit. It is critical that the display of the unit is clearly visible in daylight, that the unit is durable (MIL-STD-810G for drops) and weather resistance (IP65 standard). We recommend the Panasonic Tough Book CF-20 (see attached specification) as the product specification to use for this critical element.
