AMENDMENT 0006

1. This amendment hereby revised the responses to PPIs 0075, 0076 and 0092 originally provided in Amendment 0004. The PPI responses are revised as follows:

PPI 0075

1. What is the estimated date that the temporary facilities will need to be in place?
2. What is the estimated duration that the temporary facilities will need to be in place?
3. Will there be a formal site walk of the lay down area for the temporary kitchen and break room?
4. Will the dining take place in the temporary break room? If not, where will the dining be located?
5. Will carts for transportation of food be necessary? Is there a need for a cart wash area?
6. Is there a requirement for a loading dock at the temporary kitchen?
7. What size forklift is needed in the dry storage area?
8. Is there a requirement for a trash enclosure?

Revised Response

1. The demolition of the fire station and kitchen areas in building 435 cannot begin until temporary facilities are completed. The Government anticipates the construction of the temporary facilities will be an early phase of this project.
2. The period of performance for this contract is 698 days. The Government anticipates these trailers will be in place for a majority of this time.
3. No, there will not be a formal site walk of the lay down area for the temporary kitchen and break room.
4. No, all food prepared here is transported to other locations for sale and consumption. There will be no dining in the temporary kitchen.
5. No, the contractor is not required to handle any food. Therefore, there is no need for a cart wash area.
6. No, all goods are hand dollied up ramp, or offloaded at street side of building through double doors.

7. Forklift will not enter building. Only fork hand truck will be used inside the facility.

8. Yes. Provide trash enclosure to match current enclosure at B435.

13. Contractor shall connect all GFE inside temporary kitchen.

14. Electrical equipment will come with cords but new flexible gas lines will need to be routed.

15. Walk in freezers and refrigerators are remote units with compressors located outside.
