

## Combined Synopsis/Solicitation: N61340-17-T-0003

This is a combined synopsis/solicitation for commercial items prepared in accordance with the format in Subpart 12.6, as supplemented with additional information included in this notice. Naval Air Warfare Center Training Systems Division (NAWCTSD) intends to issue a Firm-Fixed-Price (FFP) purchase order for fifteen (15) Dell computers as described under CLIN 0001 below.

Interested sources may identify their interest and capability to respond to the requirement, which demonstrates their ability to meet the needs of the Government. Interested sources are encouraged to submit a quote. A determination by the Government not to compete this proposed action based upon responses to this notice is solely within the discretion of the Government.

This announcement constitutes the only solicitation; quotes are being requested and A WRITTEN SOLICITATION WILL NOT BE ISSUED. Combined synopsis/solicitation **N61340-17-T-0003** is issued as a request for quote (RFQ) and incorporates the provisions and clauses in effect from regulations posted to <http://farsite.hill.af.mil> inclusive, but not limited to, Federal Acquisition Circular (FAC) number FAC 2005-89, dated 01 November 2016.

The associated North American Classification System (NAICS) code is 334118 with a size standard of 1,000 employees. This procurement is not being solicited as a small business set-aside.

No financing will be provided for the resulting award.
