Pre-Proposal Inquiries:

1. QUESTION: Request that the Government allows for SF330 to be submitted using 10 point font size.
RESPONSE: 10 point font size is allowed for the submission.
2. QUESTION: Will any weighted consideration be made for Small Businesses submissions?
RESPONSE: This procurement is unrestricted using full and open competition procedures. No additional consideration will be made for Small Business submission.
3. QUESTION: In the solicitation Criterion 2 states “Additionally, a hospitality planner and professional member of Hospitality Design Institute (HDI) or equivalent certification is required on each Lodge project.” We can find no HDI certification or any “Hospitality Design Institute” organization. Is this correct? If so, can you please clarify what other certifications would be equivalent?
RESPONSE: Criterion 2 is revised; please refer to the revised notice of intent.
4. QUESTION: Is this solicitation a re-issuance of an existing contract? If so can you tell me the name of the company currently contracted for these design services?
RESPONSE: The incumbent contract number is N62470-13-D-3003. The incumbent contractor is HBA Architecture & Interior Design, Inc.
5. QUESTION: Are we allowed to use relevant projects that we personally worked on at another firm in Section F, and note it as individual experience?
RESPONSE: In accordance with the synopsis, all projects provided in the SF 330 must be completed by the office/branch/regional office/individual team member actually proposed to manage and/or perform work under this contract.
6. QUESTION: Is NAVFAC requiring two hospitality planner resumes, or at least one that is a professional member of Hospitality Design Institute (HDI) or equivalent.
RESPONSE: Criterion 2 is revised; please refer to the revised notice of intent
7. QUESTION: We are unable to identify the HDI membership referenced in the solicitation. Would an International Interior Design Association (IIDA) membership accompanied with hospitality planning experience be considered equivalent?
RESPONSE: Criterion 2 is revised; please refer to the revised notice of intent.
