52.212-2 EVALUATION--COMMERCIAL ITEMS (OCT 2014)

(a) The Government will select an awardee based on the evaluation criteria set forth below. Award will be made to firm whose quote conforming to the solicitation is the lowest price technically acceptable. Non-price factors will be evaluated on an acceptable or unacceptable basis. To be considered technically acceptable, offerors' quote must receive a rating of "acceptable" for each non-price factor.

Factor (1): Technical Capability

1. The quoter shall provide evidence of having experience in scheduling and escorting oversized and overweight loads through city and densely populated areas with a lead time of 48 hours or less. Minimum load dimensions are 15'4" high, 27'6" wide, and 56' long. Experience shall be demonstrated by providing a written summary outlining, at a minimum, the following:

Describe escort moves conducted at least 3 times within the last 18 months. The description shall include:

- Type equipment/material escorted/moved**
- Size of item being moved (height, width, and length)**
- Lead time for move (date move request received and date of move)**
- Route(s) taken (i.e., through densely populated or high traffic areas, via interstate, state roads, etc.)**

2. The quoter shall provide evidence of or certify in writing that they have maintained a fault free incident record for the last 18 months.

3. The quoter shall provide a copy of its certificate of completion for the "pilot/escort" course. The quoter shall also provide a copy of this certificate for any proposed subcontractor(s).

4. The quoter shall affirm in writing that it and all of its proposed subcontractors meet all escort requirements as required by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and as identified below:

- FOUR (4) LAW ENFORCEMENT ESCORTS**
- TWO (2) WARNING LIGHTS**
- HIGH VISIBILITY FLAGS (MIN. 18 INCHES SQUARE) ARE REQUIRED.**
- ONE (1) QUALIFIED ESCORT WITH A VERTICAL HEIGHT INDICATOR IS REQUIRED TO PRECEDE THE LOAD.**
- WARNING SIGNS WITH 12 INCH HIGH BLACK LETTERS ON A YELLOW BACKGROUND ARE REQUIRED ON THE FRONT & REAR OF THE VEHICLE.**

Acceptable - *The contractor has experience moving oversized and overweight loads meeting the minimum load dimensions at least 3 times within the last 18 months. The contractor has moved oversized and overweight loads through city and densely populated areas. Lead times were within 48 hours. The contractor has a fault free incident record over the last 18 months. The contractor submitted a copy of completion for pilot/escort course (including certificates for all subcontractors). The contractor (including subcontractors) meets the appropriate escort requirements as required by the FDOT.*

Unacceptable - *The contractor does not have experience moving oversized and overweight loads meeting the minimum load dimensions at least 3 times within the last 18 months. The contractor has not moved oversized and overweight loads through city and densely populated areas. Lead times were long. The contractor does not have a fault free incident record over the last 18 months. The contractor did not submit a copy of completion for pilot/escort course (including certificates for all subcontractors). The contractor (including subcontractors) does not meet the appropriate escort requirements as required by the FDOT.*

Factor 2: Past Performance - Contractor shall have two (2) customers provide past performance surveys (template attached to this solicitation) from work performed similar in scope and size within the past three (3) years. Past Performance shall also be verified in the Past Performance Information Retrieval System (PPIRS) by the Contracting Officer. Contractor shall have acceptable performance.

The following adjectival ratings apply for past performance:

Acceptable: The Contractor's current and past performance is acceptable. There are no past performance issues of concern known to the Contracting Officer. PPIRS does not contain negative past performance ratings. In the event that there is no past performance information available, the Contractor shall be rated as acceptable.

Unacceptable: The Contractor's past performance or other information available to the Government indicates unacceptable performance.

Factor 3: Price Quote

Pricing shall be firm-fixed pricing and include all cost associated with the labor required to perform the work listed in the Statement of Work. Contractors shall return a fully executed SF 1449 to include unit prices and total extended price for all Contract Line Items of the Solicitation. The price quote shall be submitted as a separate file as indicated under FAR Clause 52.212-1 Instructions to Offerors. Pricing will be evaluated based on total price provided in a fully completed, fully executed SF1449.

Failure to furnish the price quote in accordance with the instructions above shall render the quote unacceptable.

(b) Options. The Government will evaluate offers for award purposes by adding the total price for all options to the total price for the basic requirement. The Government may determine that an offer is unacceptable if the option prices are significantly unbalanced. Evaluation of options shall not obligate the Government to exercise the option(s).

(c) A written notice of award or acceptance of an offer, mailed or otherwise furnished to the successful offeror within the time for acceptance specified in the offer, shall result in a binding contract without further action by either party. Before the offer's specified expiration time, the Government may accept an offer (or part of an offer), whether or not there are negotiations after its receipt, unless a written notice of withdrawal is received before award.
